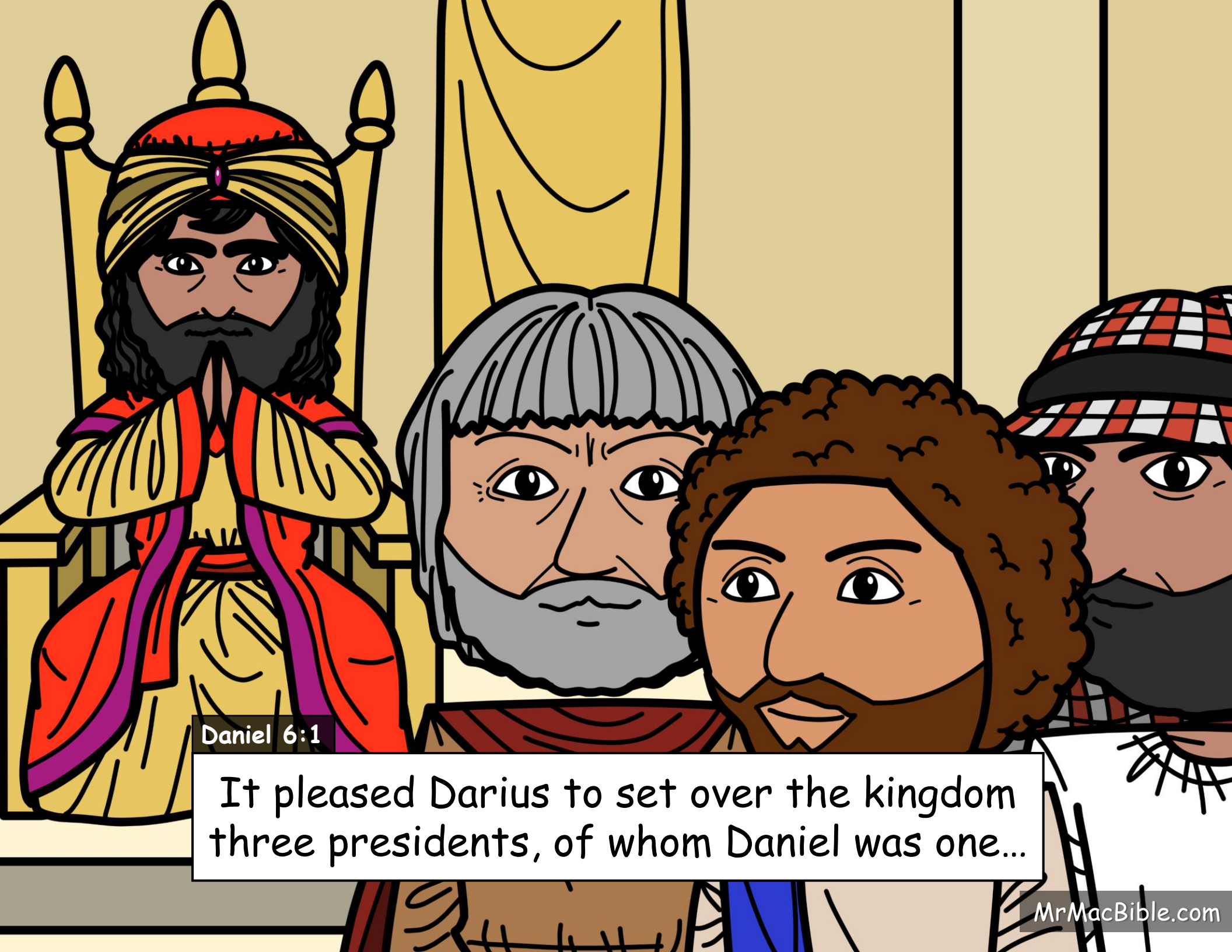

Daniel and the lions: Daniel 6

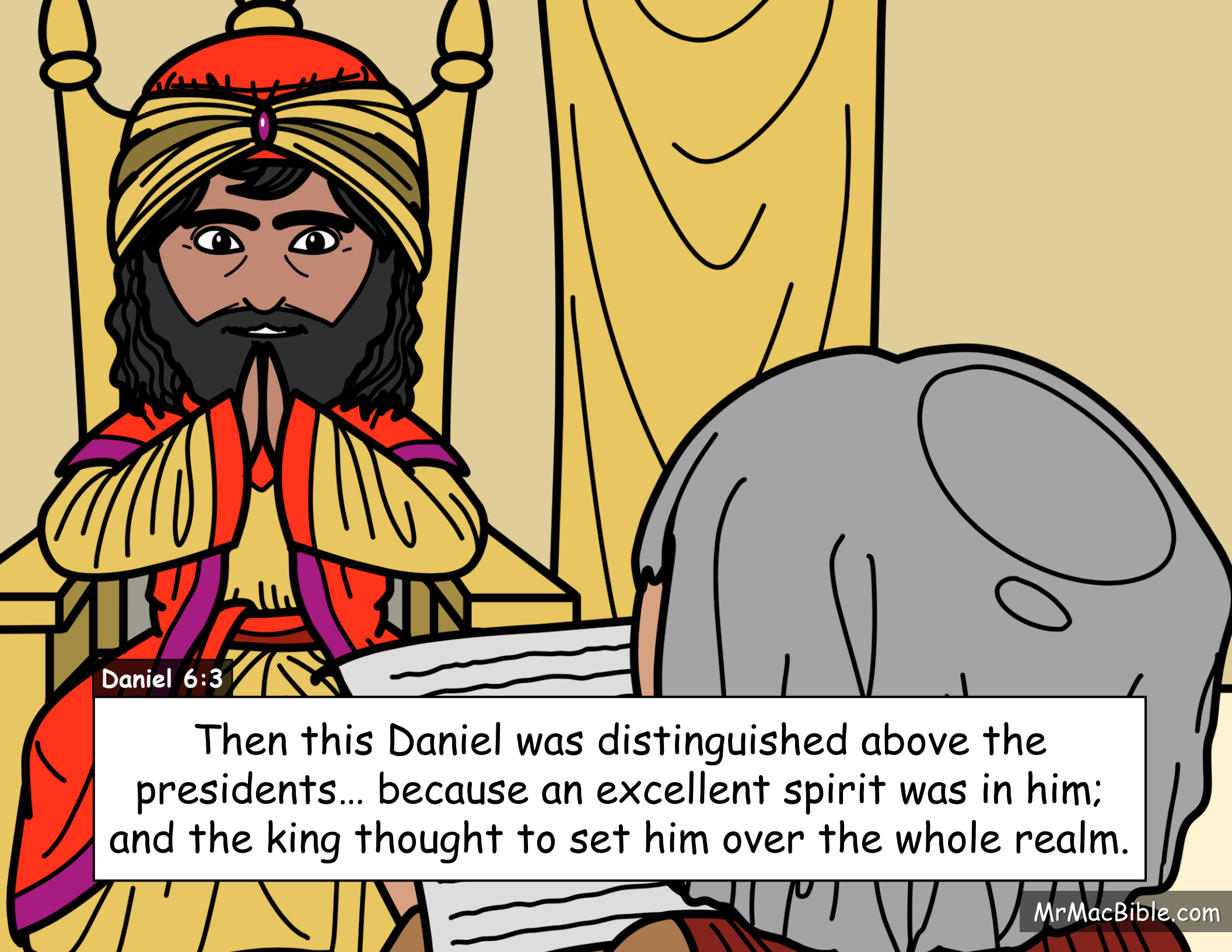
Background:

Many years after King Nebuchadnezzar died, Babylon was under the control of King Darius. Daniel was old, but still a powerful leader. So Daniel's enemies set a "lion trap" for him!



Daniel 6:1

It pleased Darius to set over the kingdom three presidents, of whom Daniel was one...



Daniel 6:3

Then this Daniel was distinguished above the presidents... because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm.



Daniel 6:4

Then the presidents and the local governors sought to find occasion against Daniel as touching the kingdom;



Daniel 6:4

...but they could find no occasion or fault, because he was faithful.



Daniel 6:5

Then these men said, "We won't find any occasion against this Daniel, unless we find it against him concerning the law of his God."



Daniel 6:6

Then these presidents and local governors assembled together to the king, and said this to him, "King Darius, live forever!"



Daniel 6:6-7

[They asked the king for a new law] "that whoever asks a petition of any god or man for thirty days, except of you, O king, he shall be cast into the den of lions."



Daniel 6:9

Therefore king Darius signed the writing and the decree.



Daniel 6:10

When Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house (now his windows were open in his room towards Jerusalem) and he knelt on his knees three times a day, and prayed...



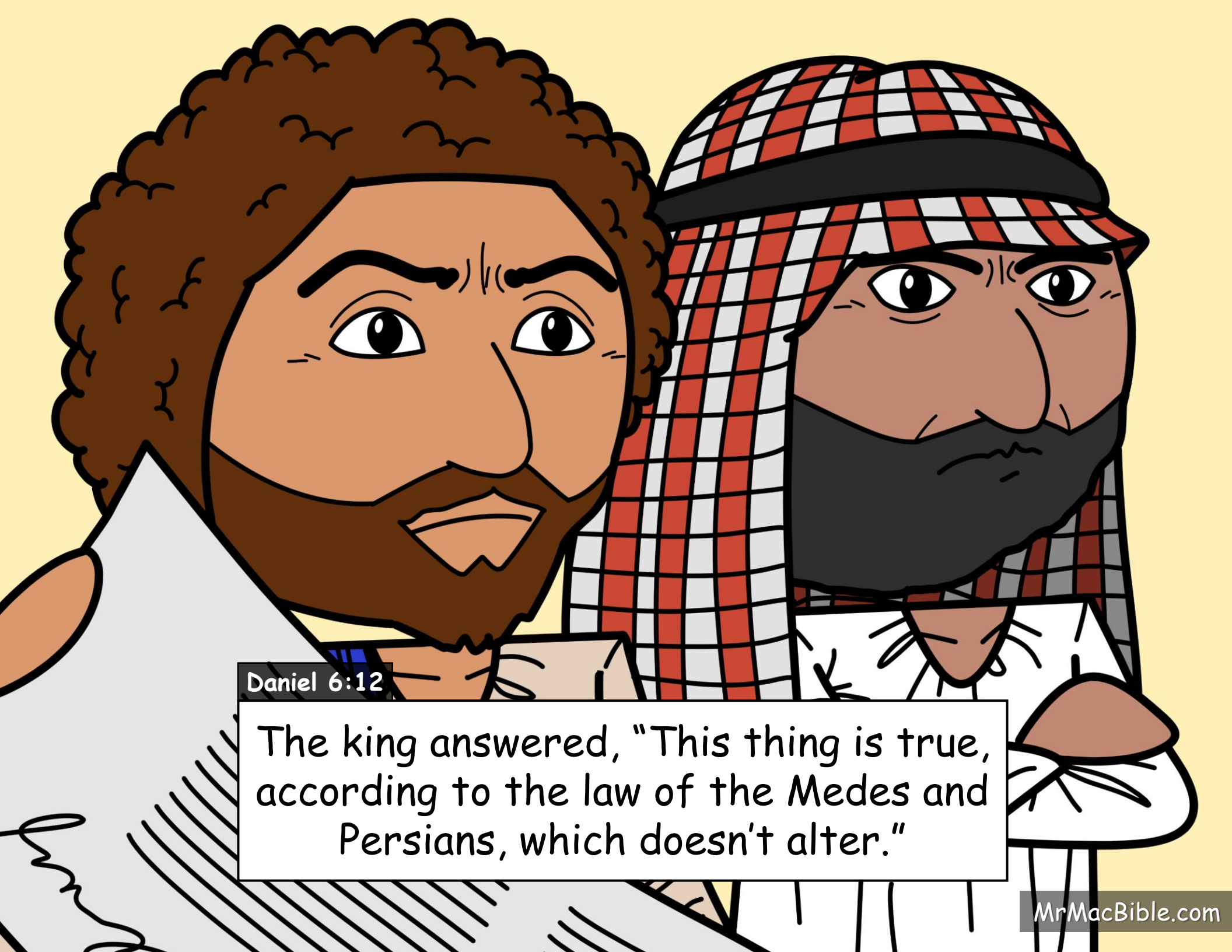
Daniel 6:11

Then these men assembled together to the king, and said to the king, "Know, O king, that it is a law of the Medes and Persians, that no decree nor statute which the king establishes may be changed."



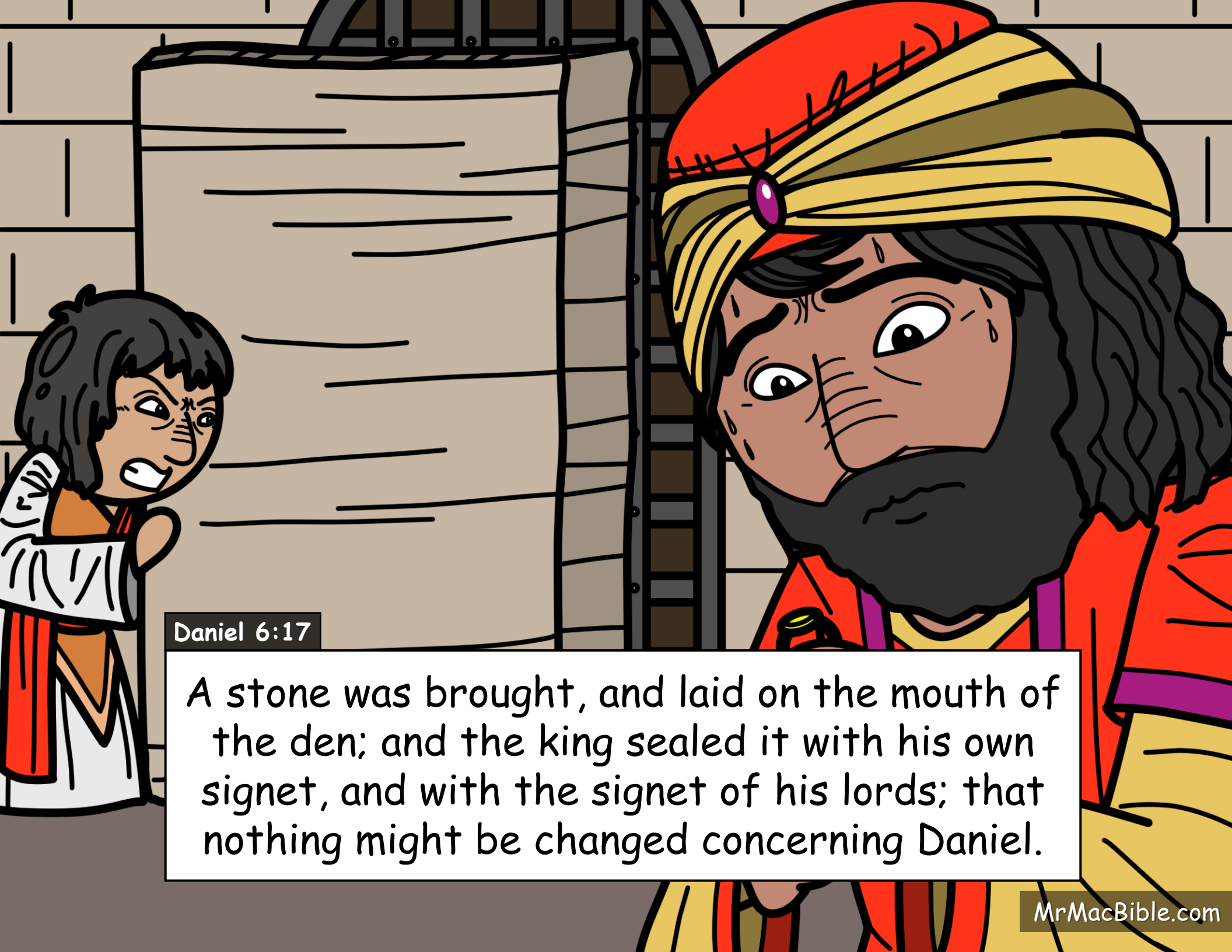
Daniel 6:16

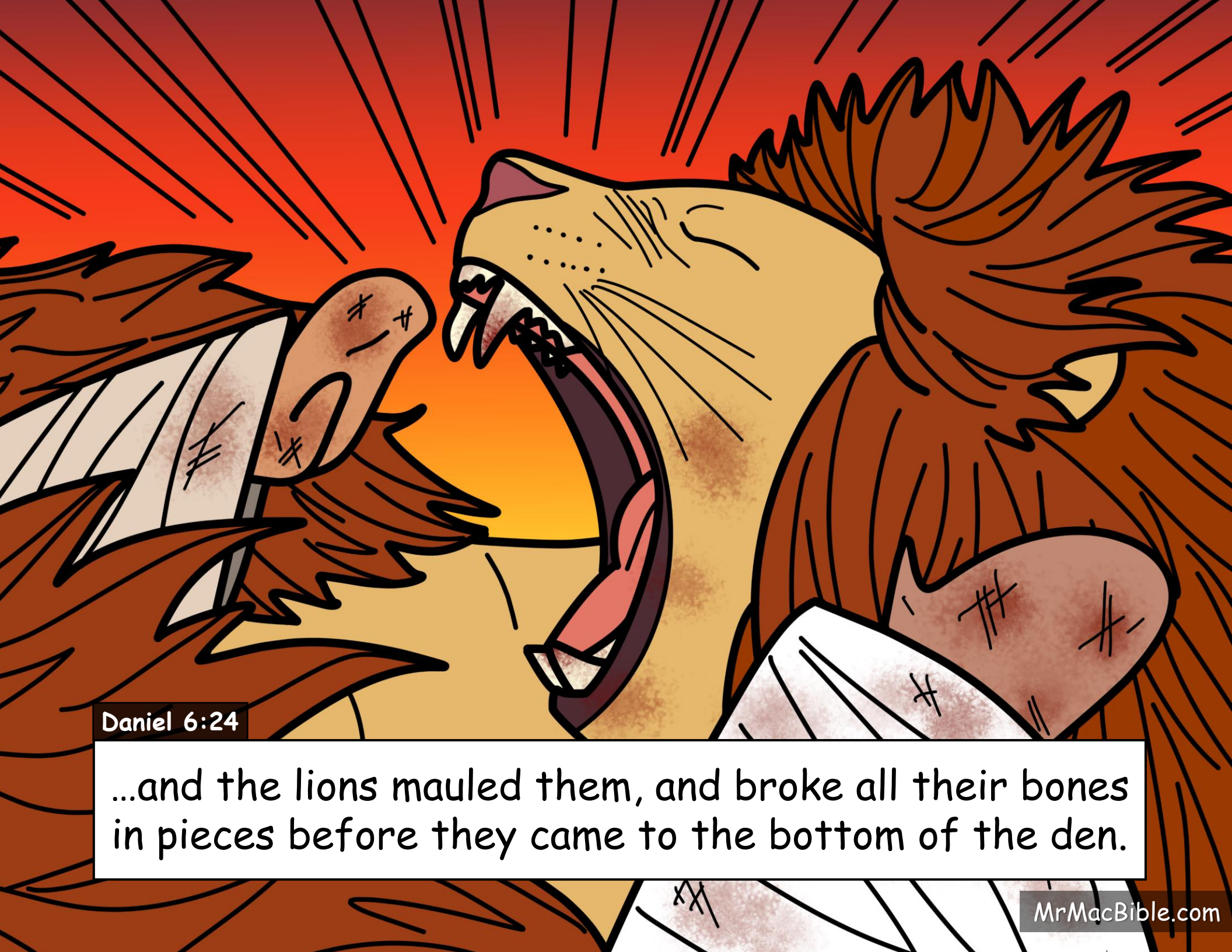

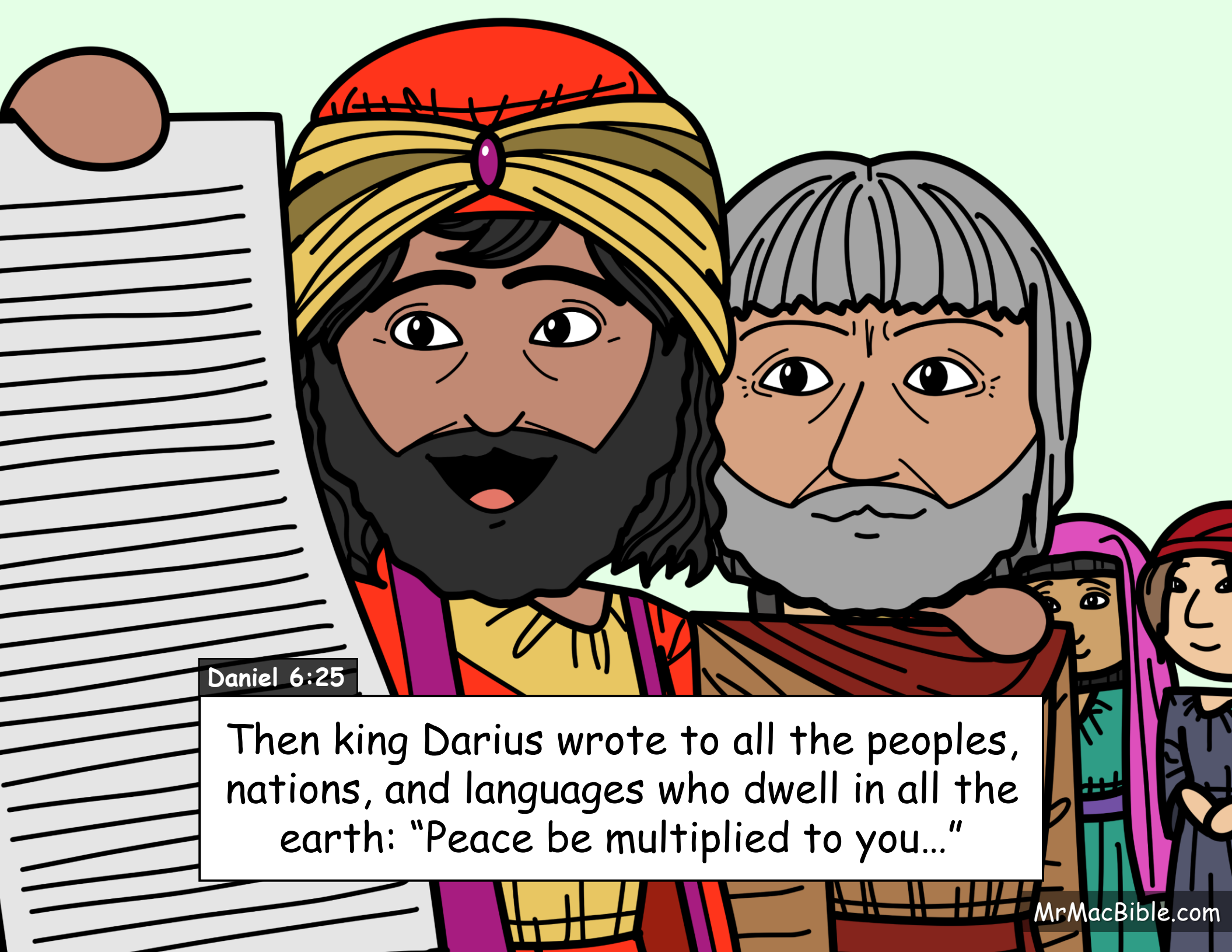

In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon, Daniel had a dream and visions of his head while on his bed.

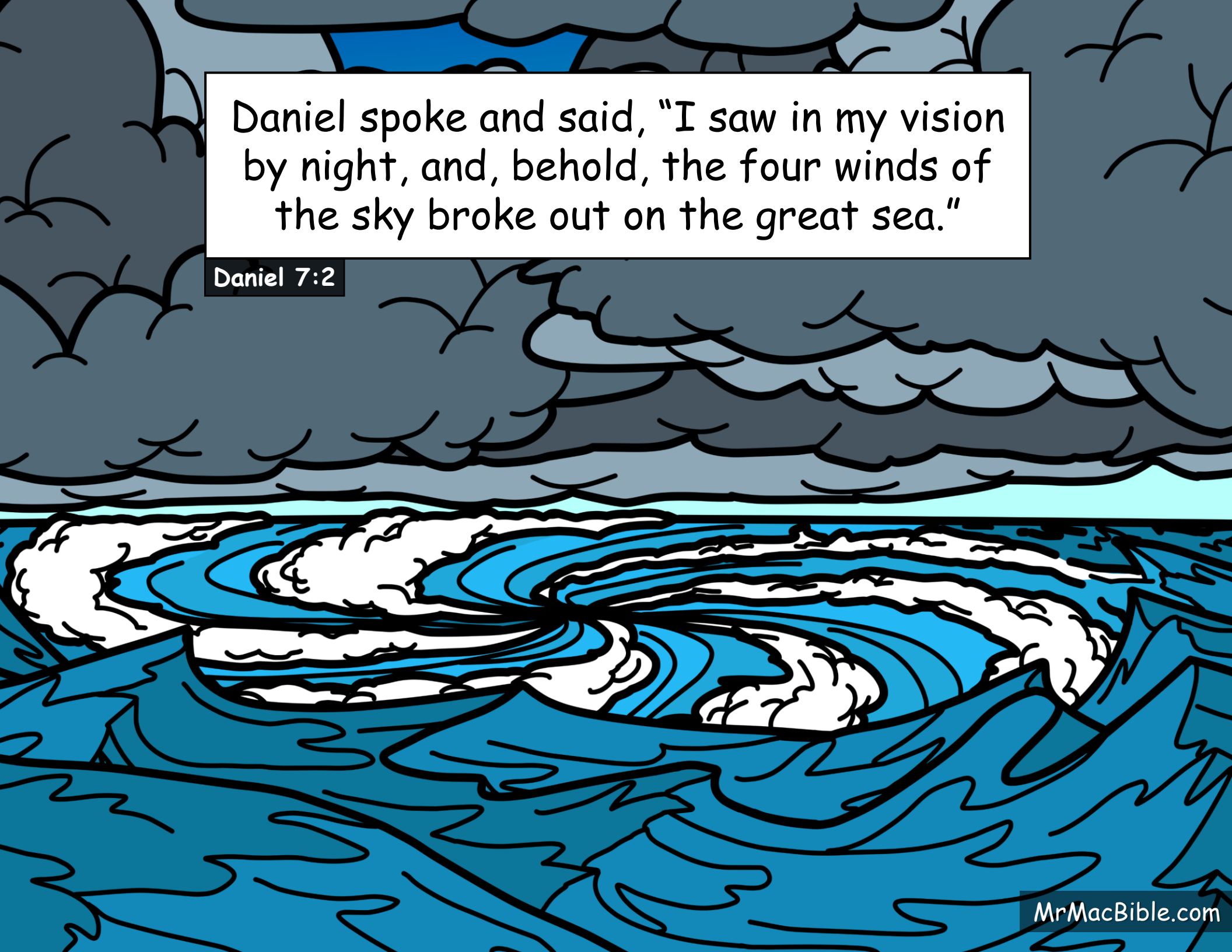
Then he wrote the dream and

It was different from all the animals that were before it. It had ten horns.

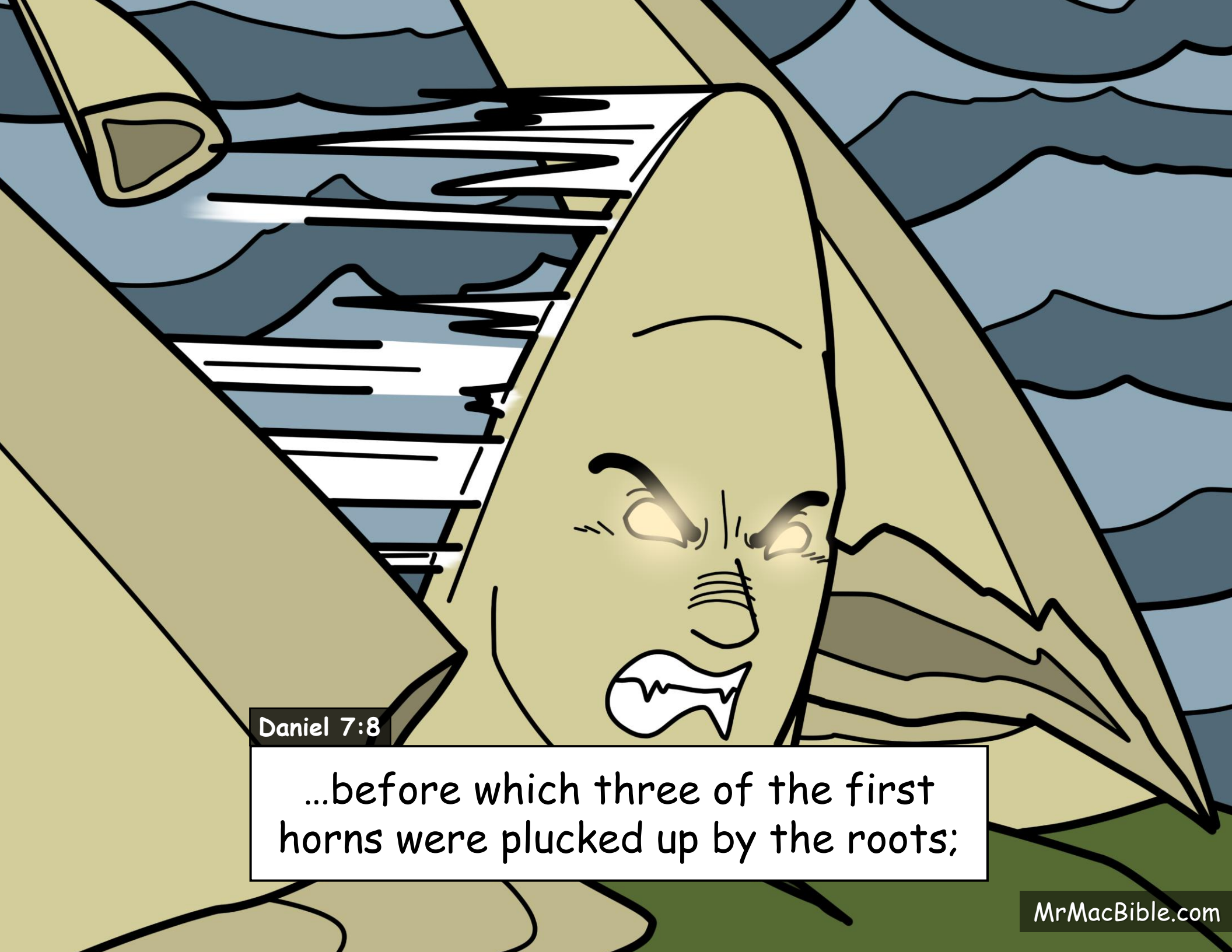

and will wear out the saints of the Most High.



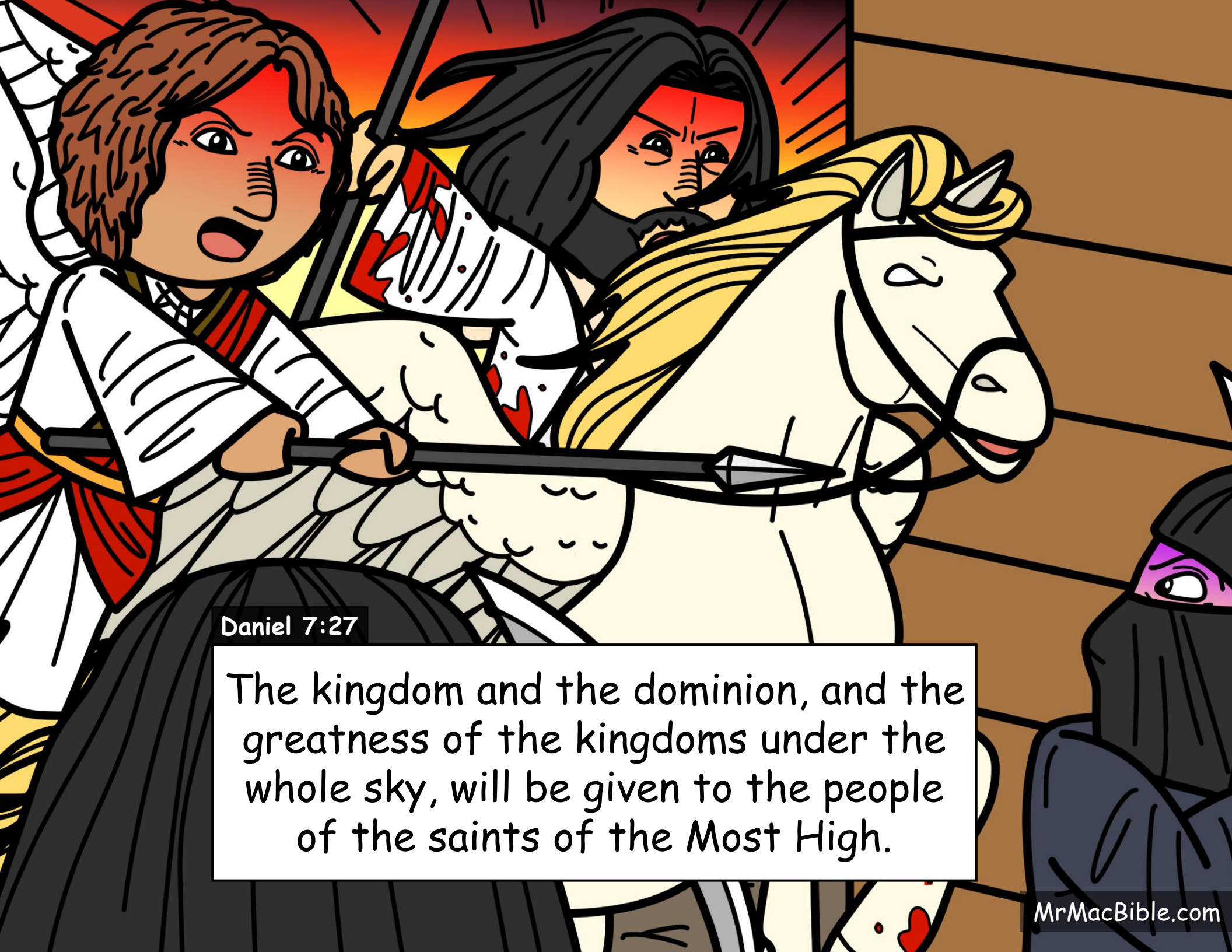

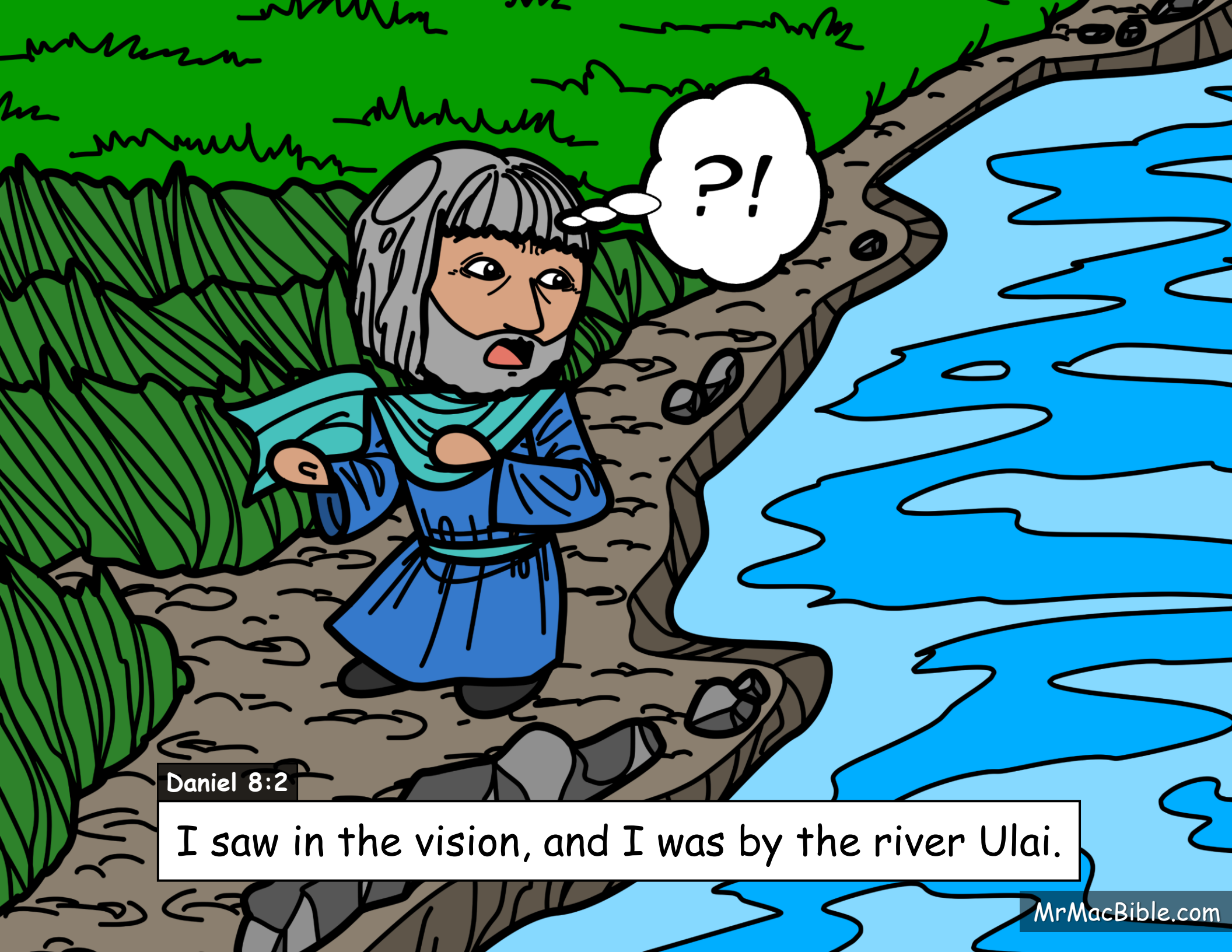
Vision 2: The Ram and the Goat

And in the future the Anti-Christ will emerge from this area of Greece and Turkey



I saw in the vision, and I was by the river Ulai.



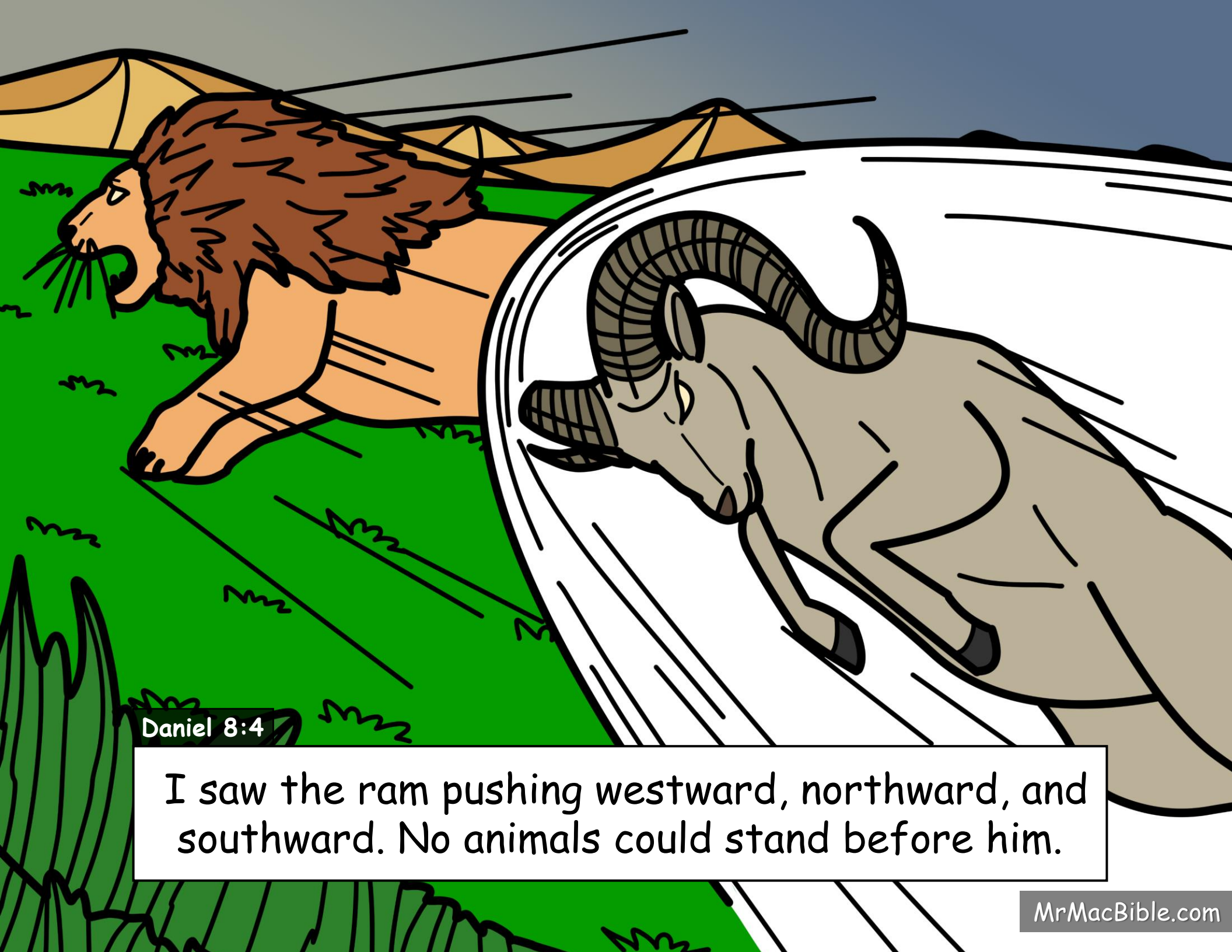
Then I lifted up my eyes and saw, and behold, a ram which had two horns stood before the river.

I saw the ram pushing westward, northward, and southward. No animals could stand before him.



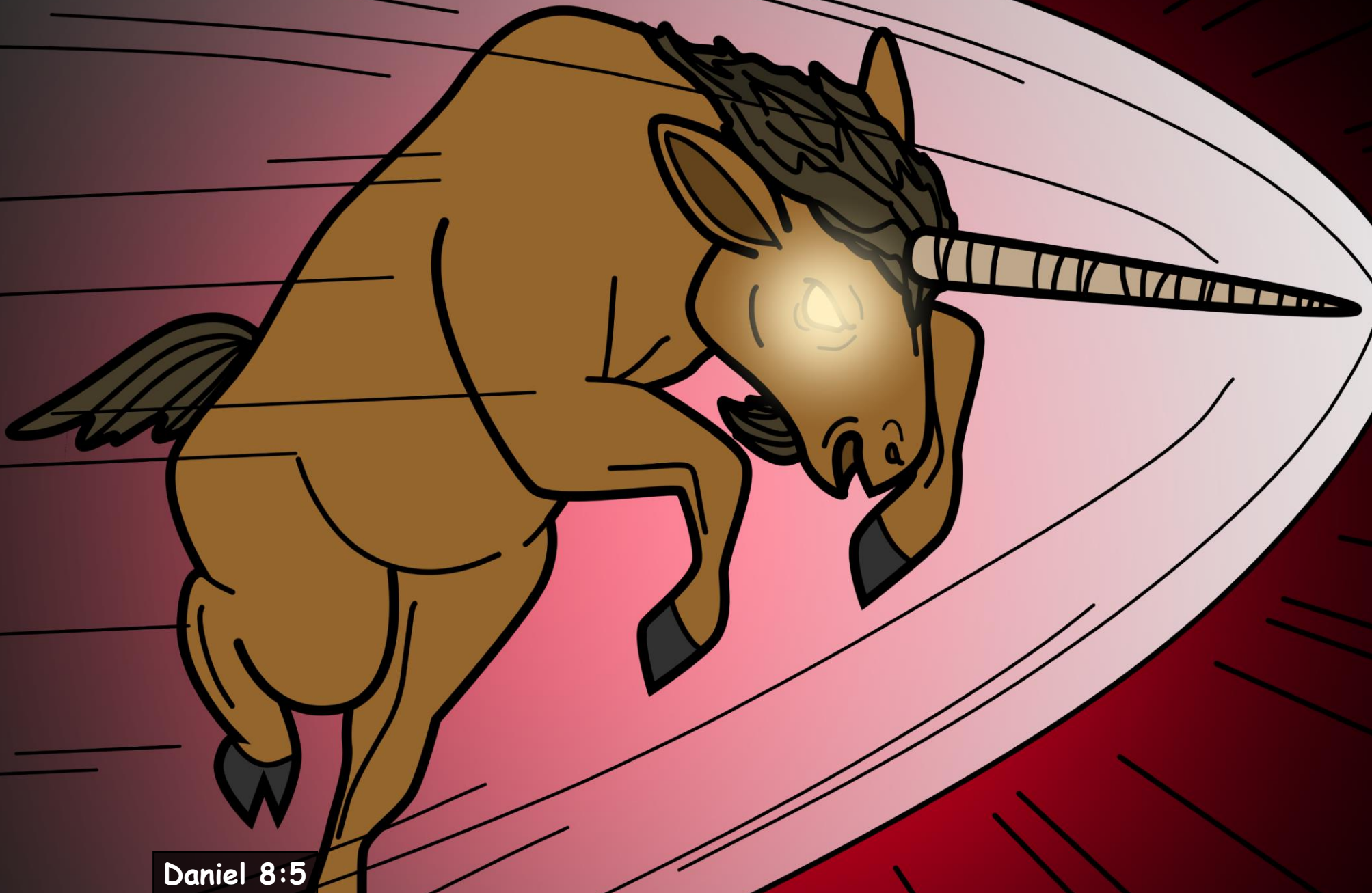
