

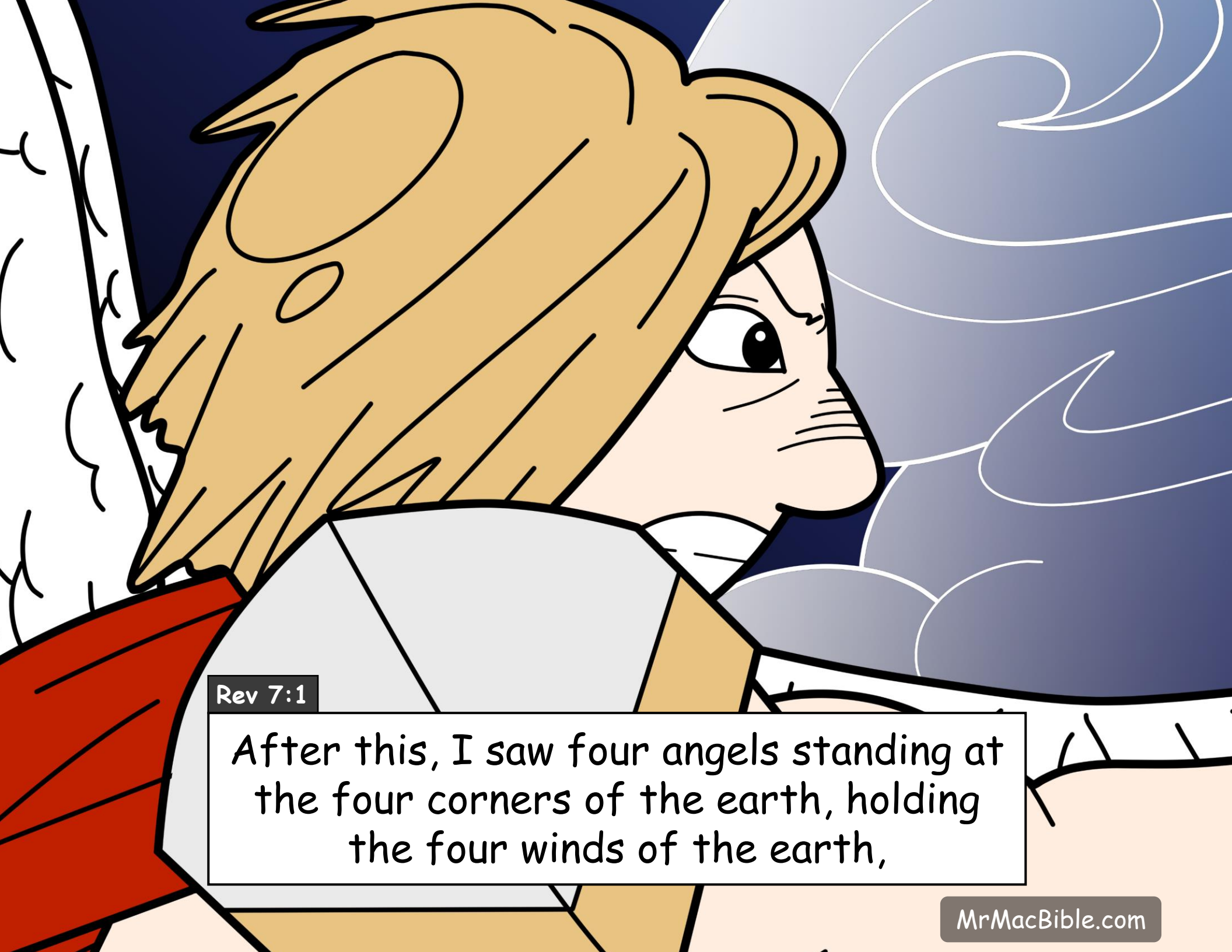


Believers in Heaven

Holding back the wind!

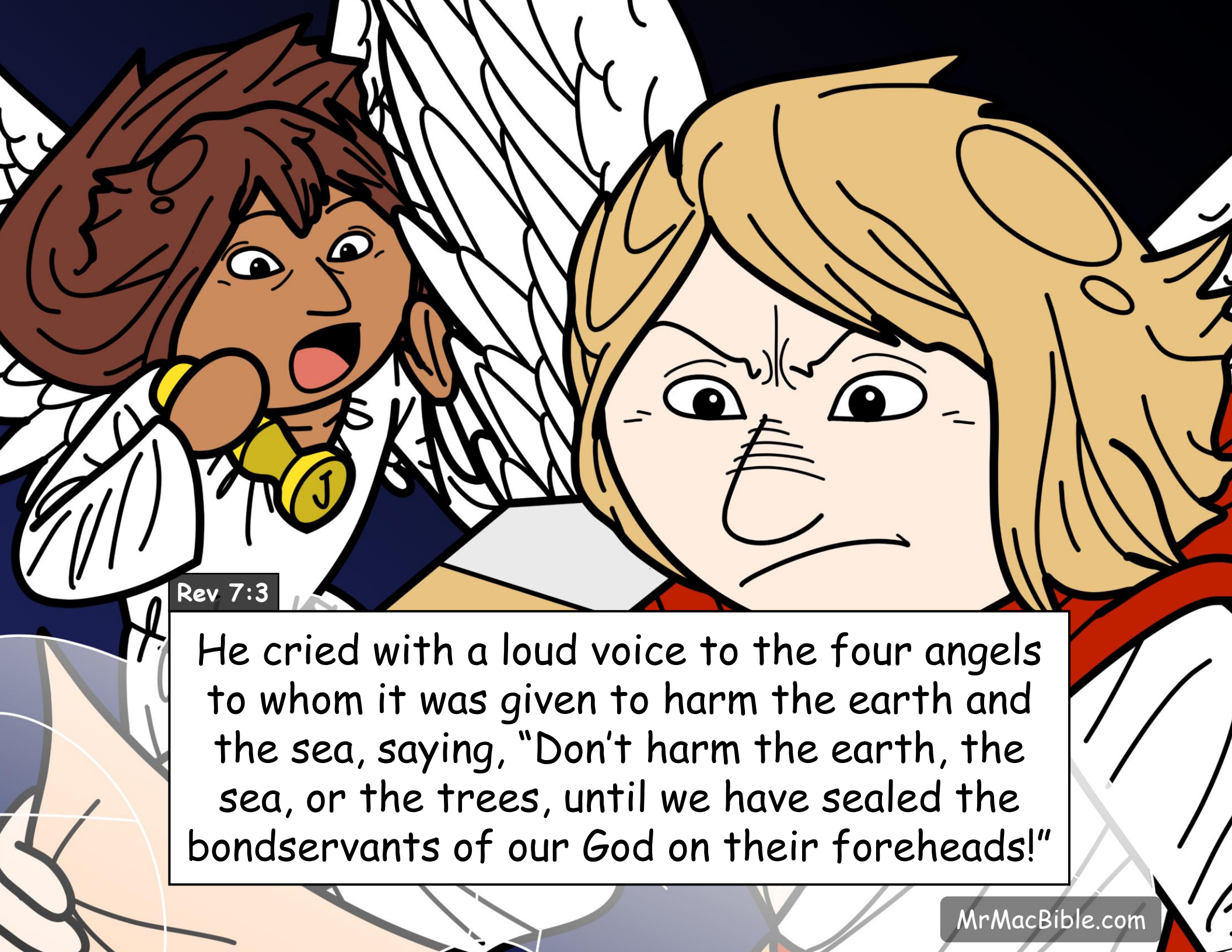
Rev 7:1

I saw another angel ascend from the sunrise, having the seal of the living God.



Rev 7:3



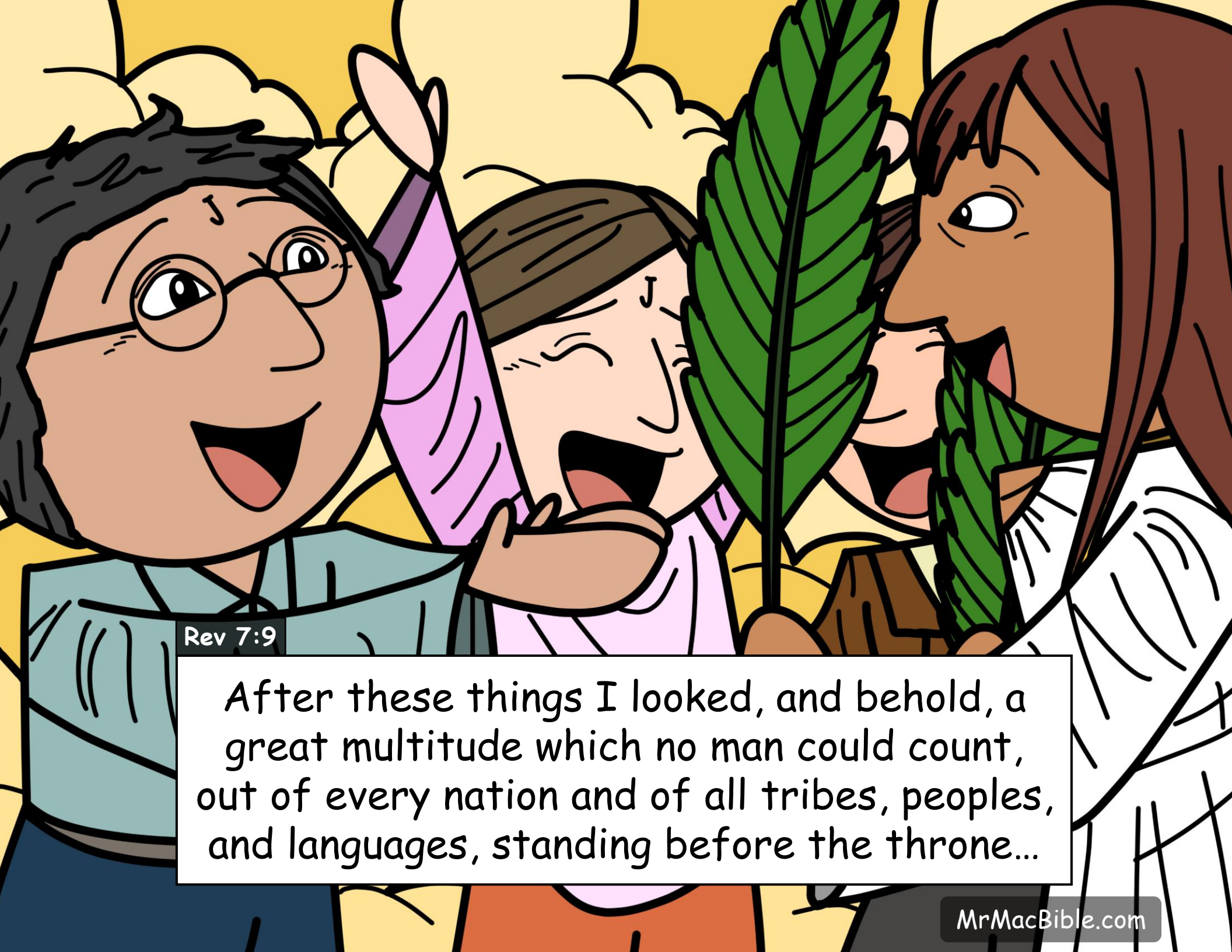

...and worshipped God, saying, "Amen! Blessing, glory, wisdom, thanksgiving, honour, power, and might, be to our God forever and ever! Amen."



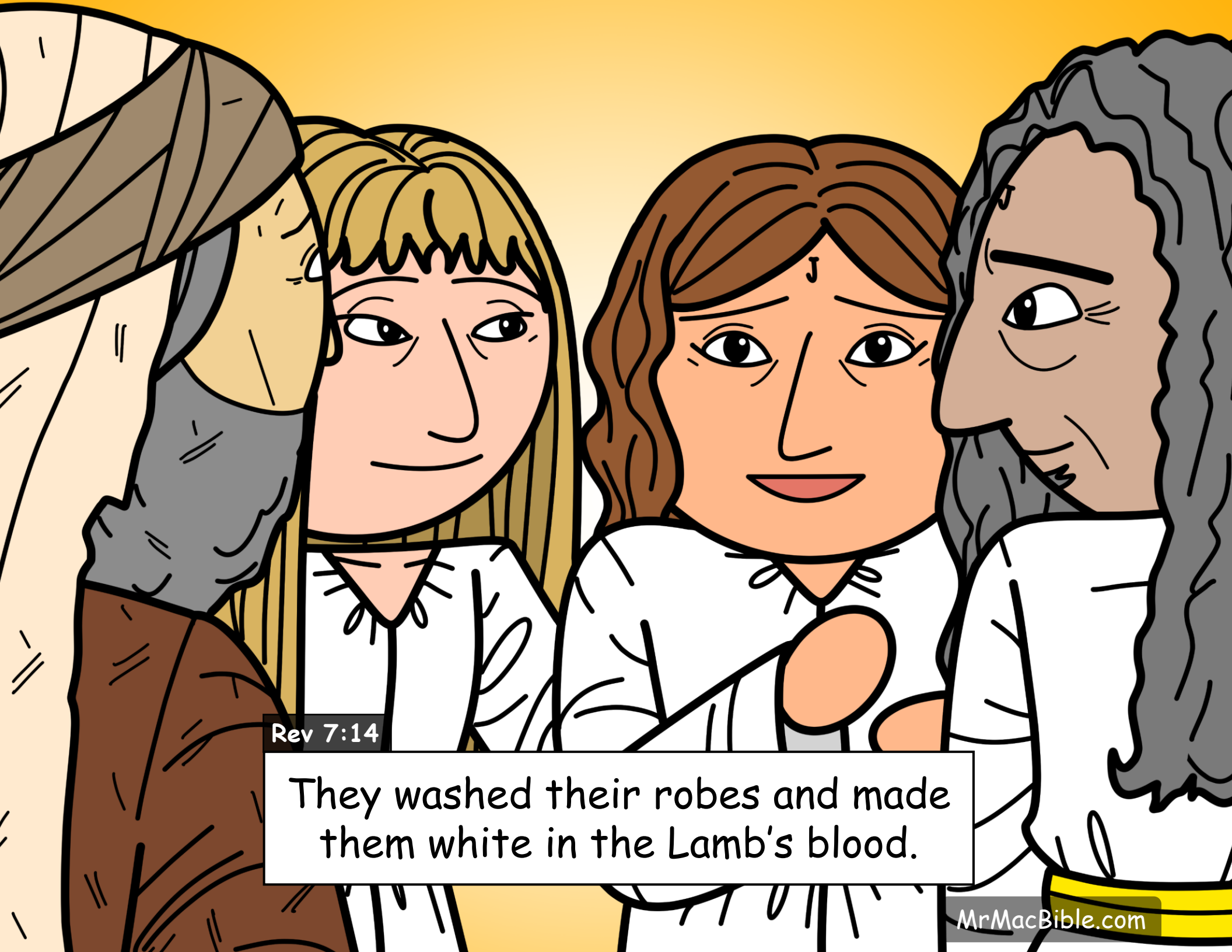
Rev 7:13

came out of the great suffering."



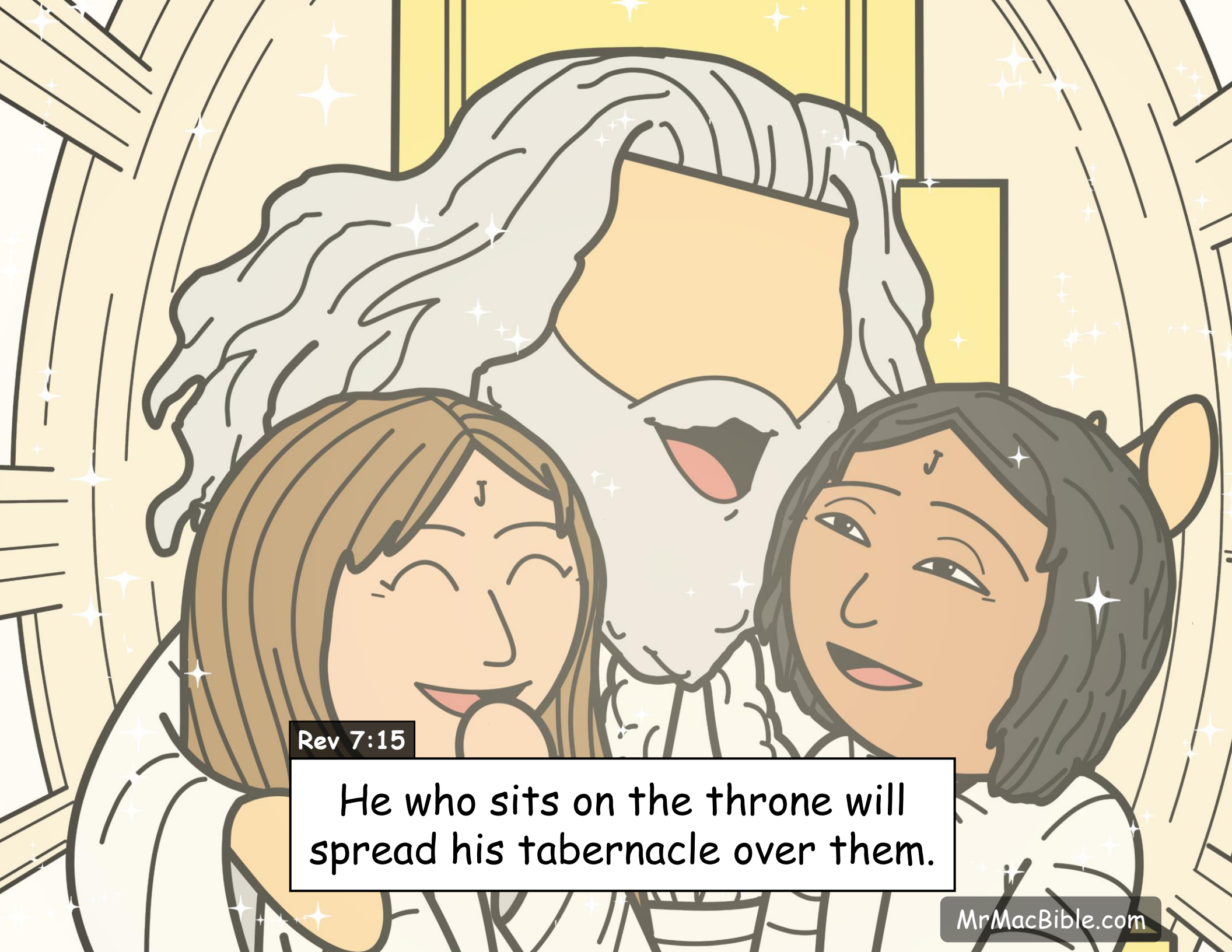
Rev 7:14

Therefore they are before the throne of God, and they serve him day and night in his temple.



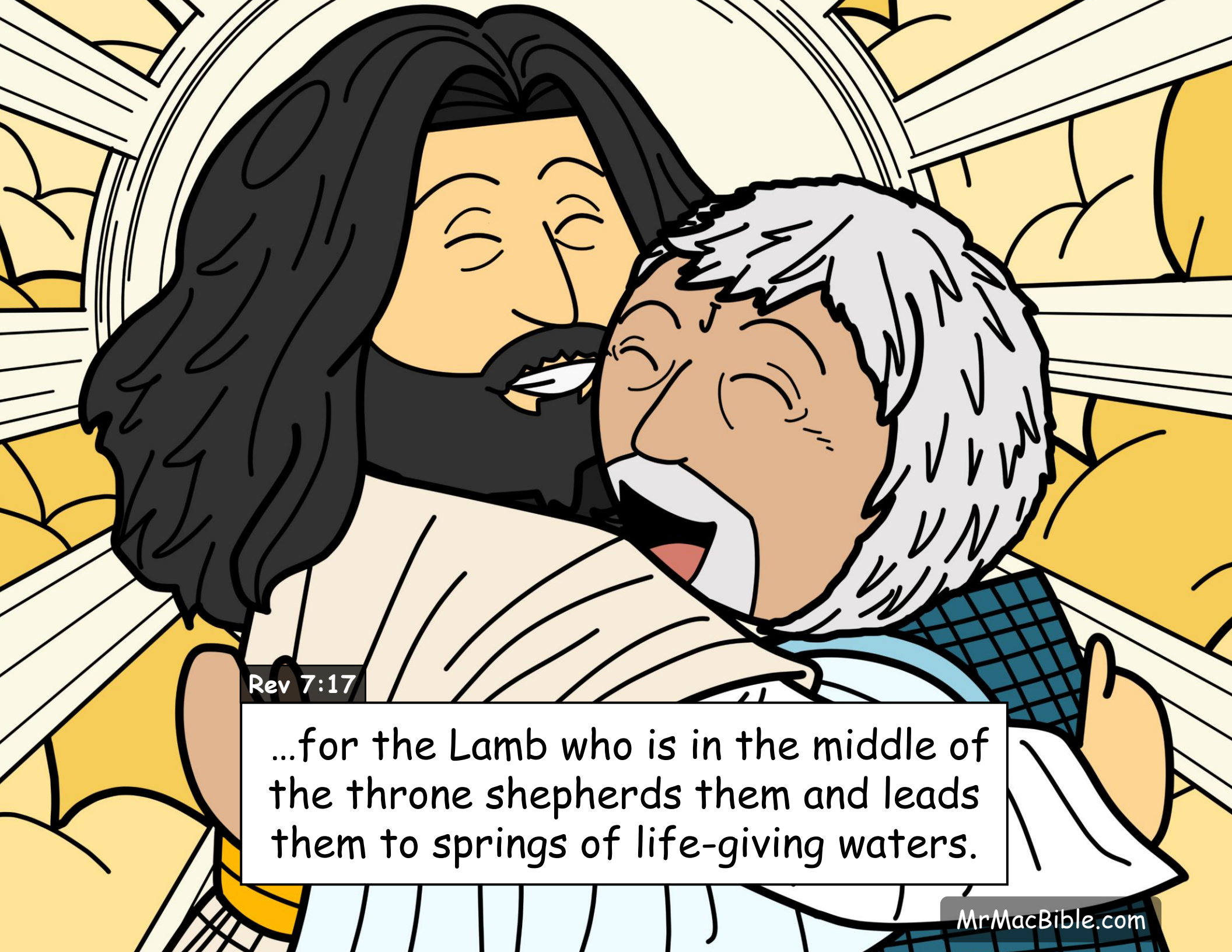
Rev 7:15

Jesus is ready to release "the wrath of God" on His enemies starting with the trumpets of the seven angels.



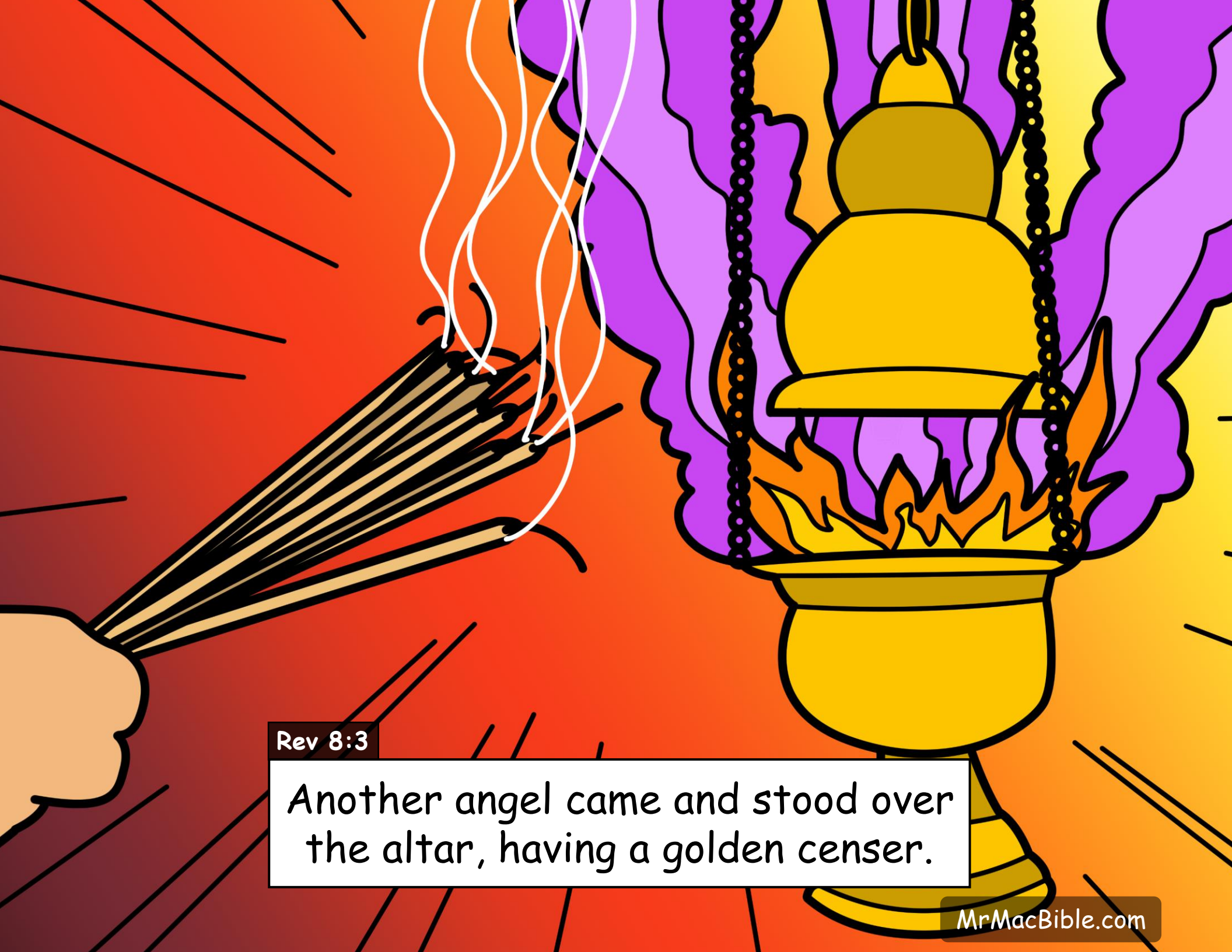
Rev 8:1

Another angel came and stood over the altar, having a golden censer.



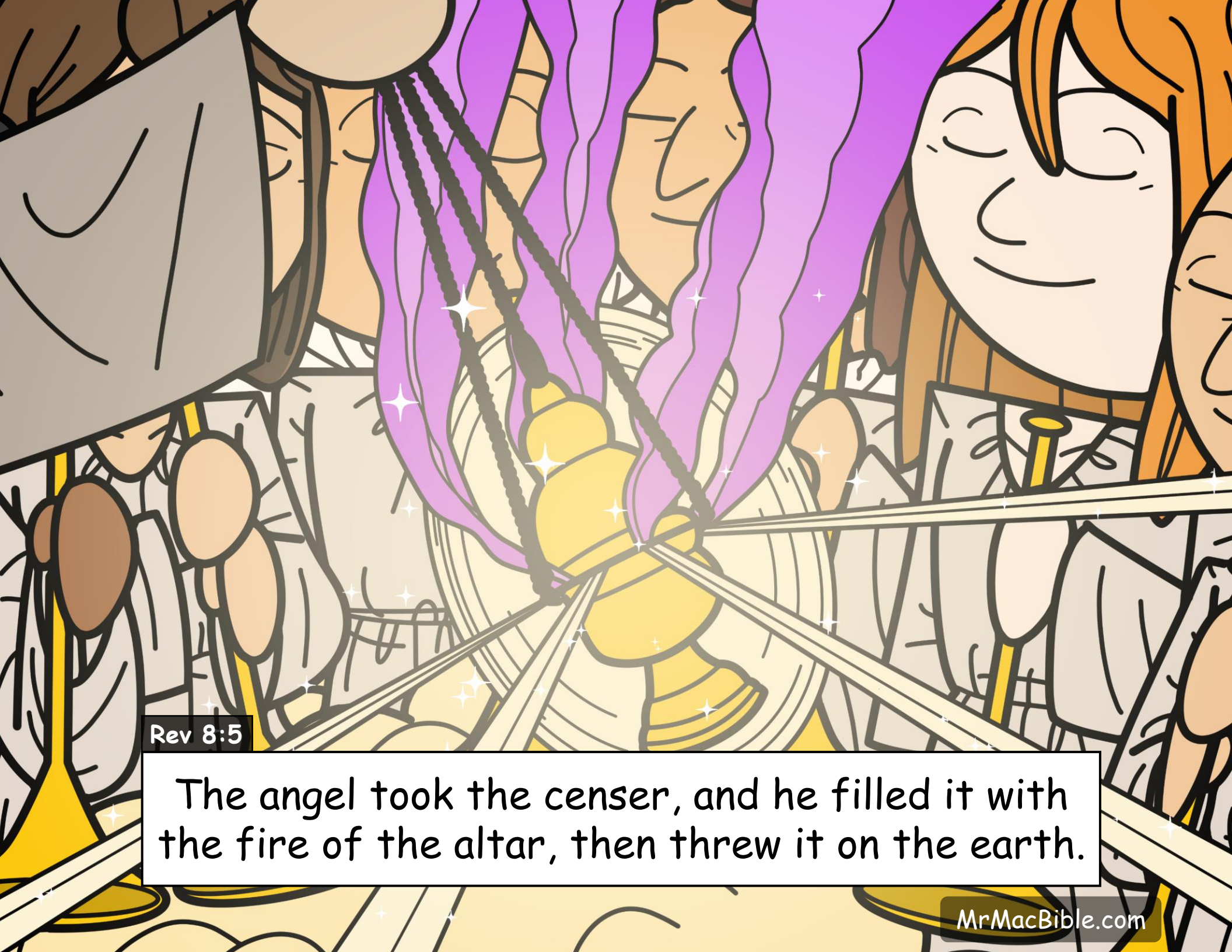
Rev 8:3

Much incense was given to him, that he should add it to the prayers of all the saints on the golden altar which was before the throne.



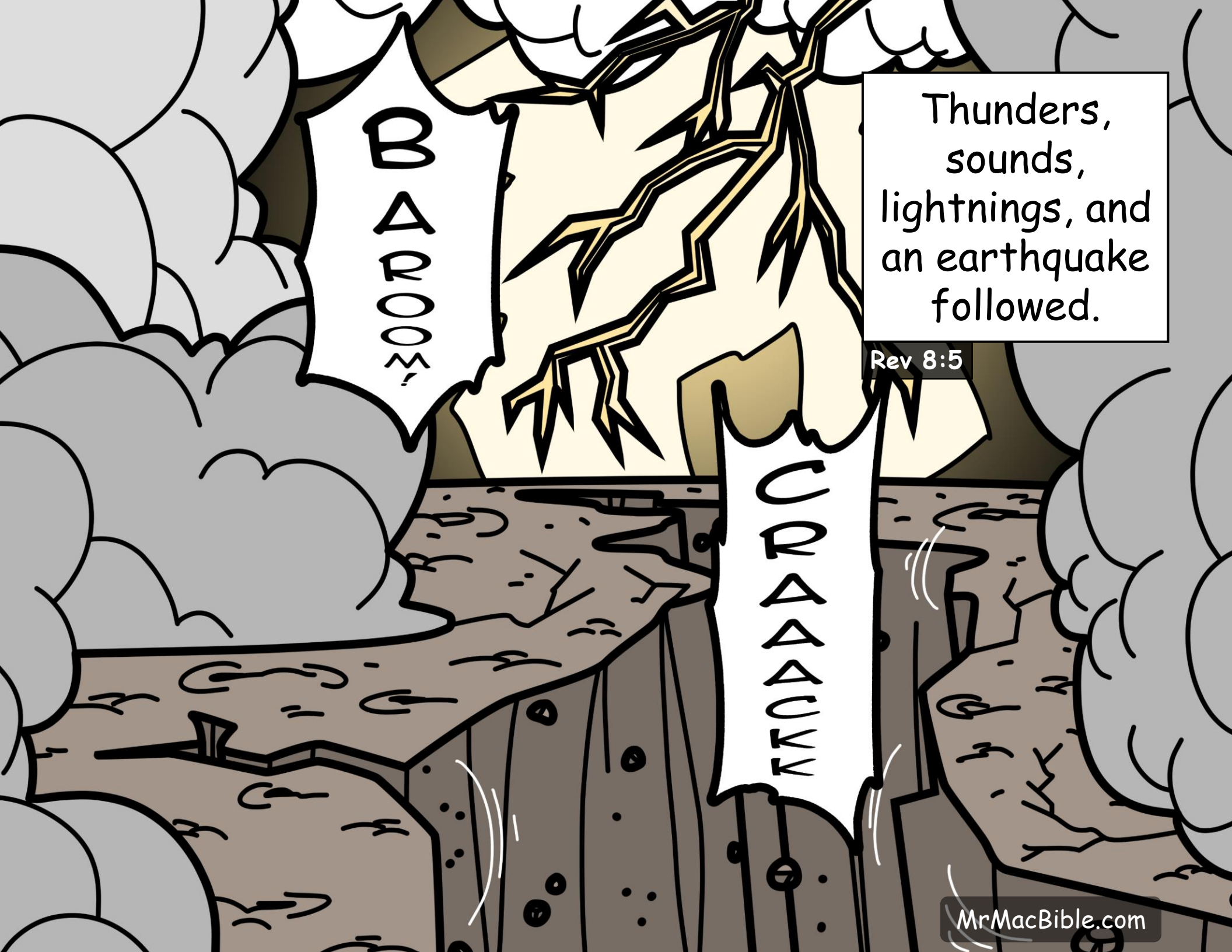
Rev 8:4

The angel took the censer, and he filled it with the fire of the altar, then threw it on the earth.

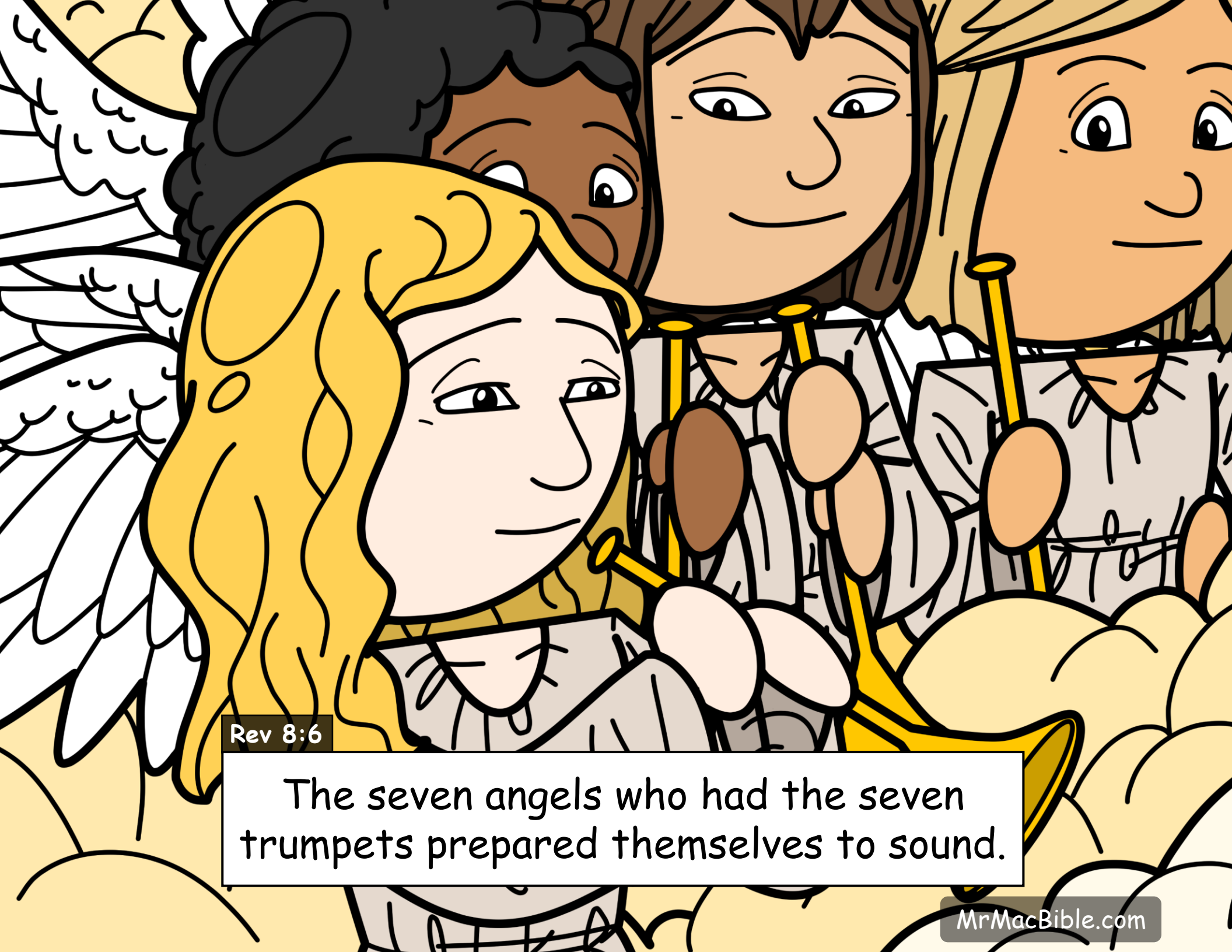

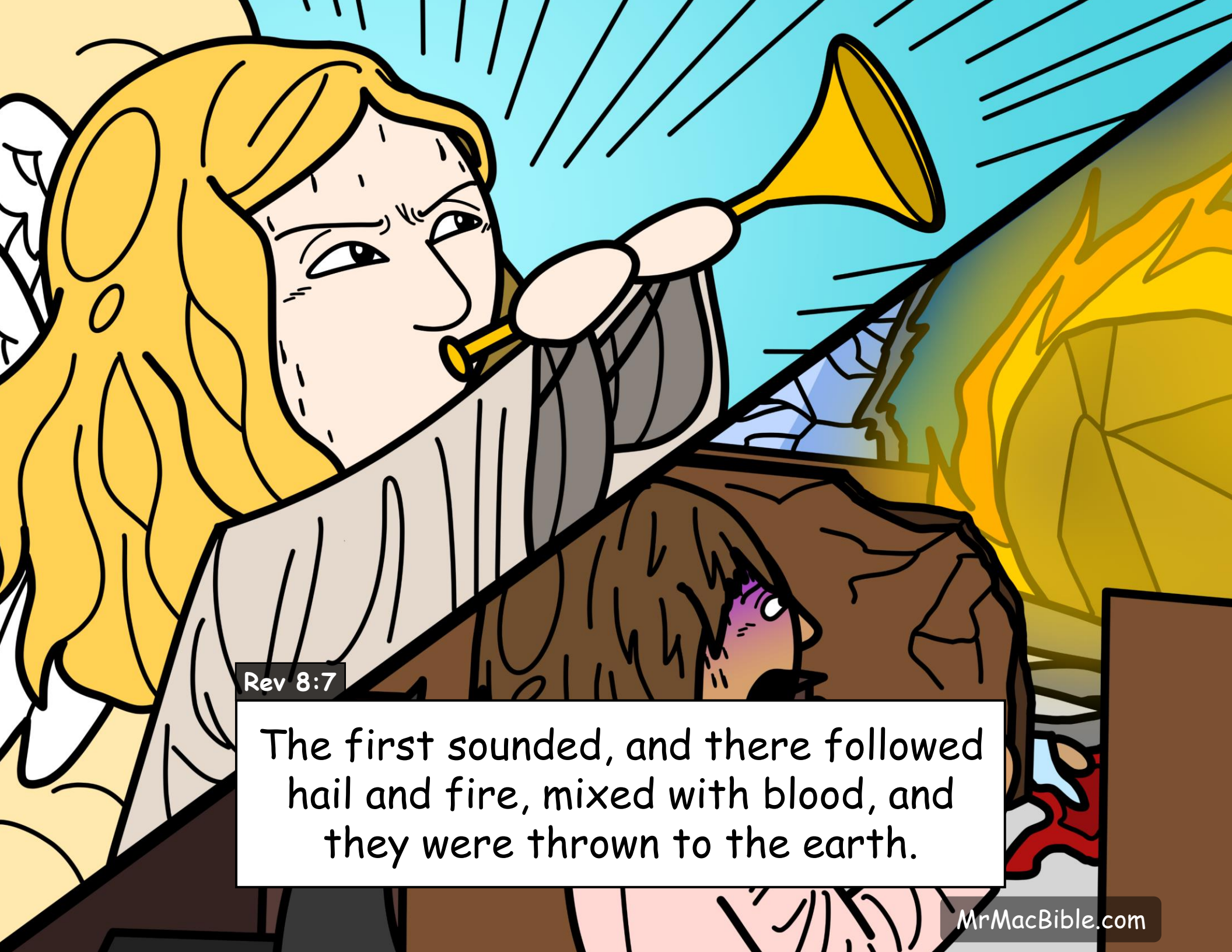

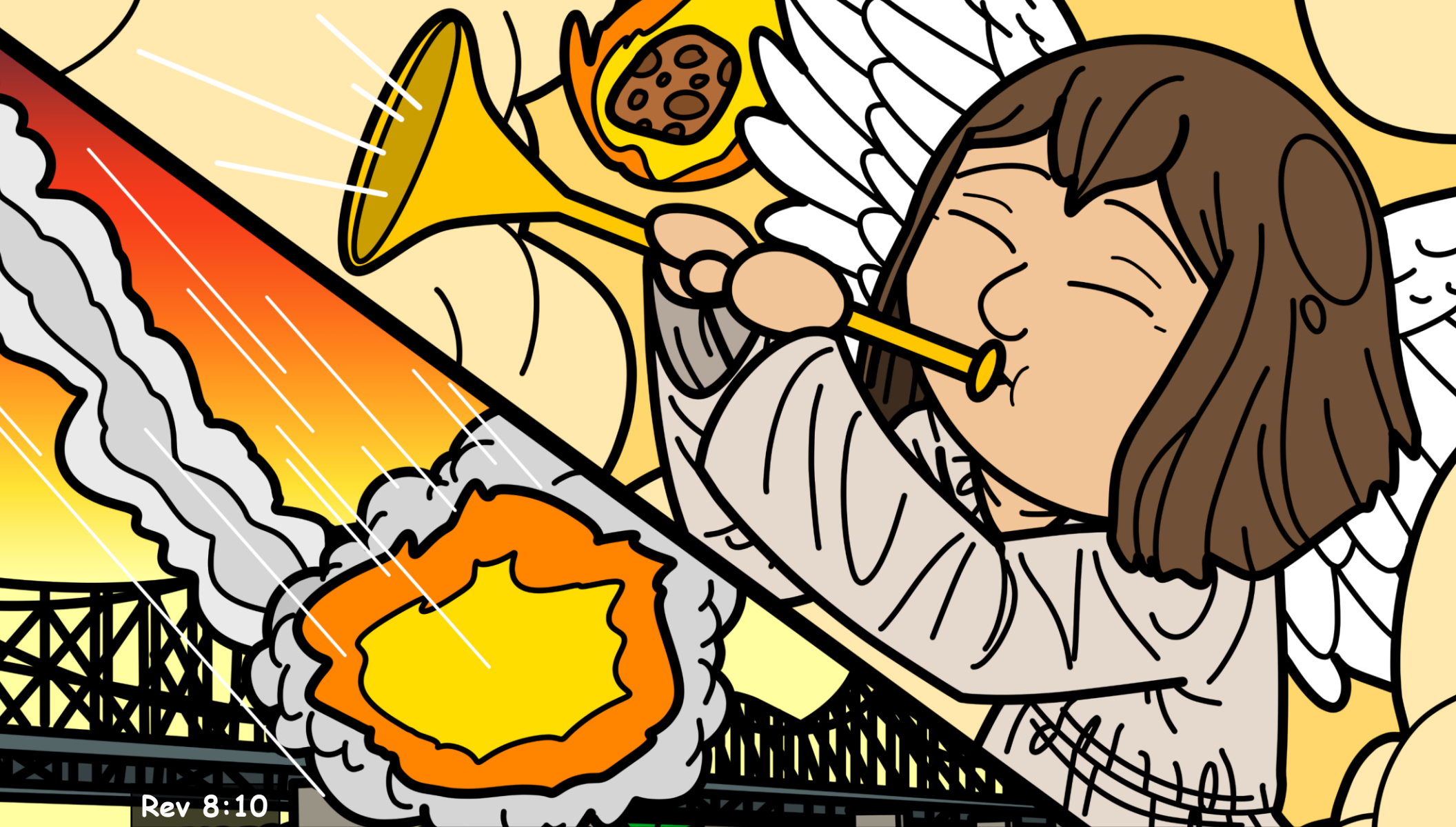

The fourth angel sounded, and one third of the sun was struck, and one third of the moon,



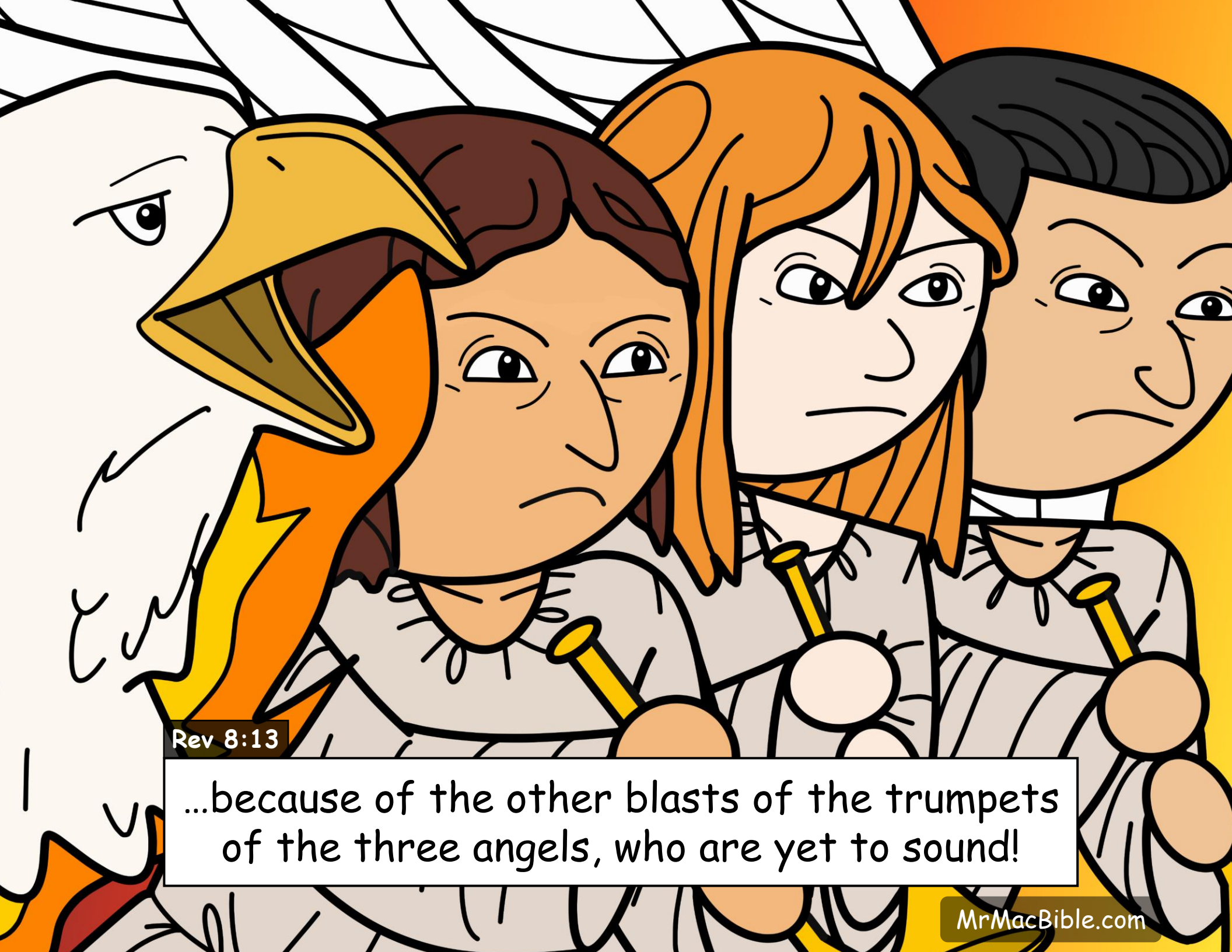

Rev 9:1-11

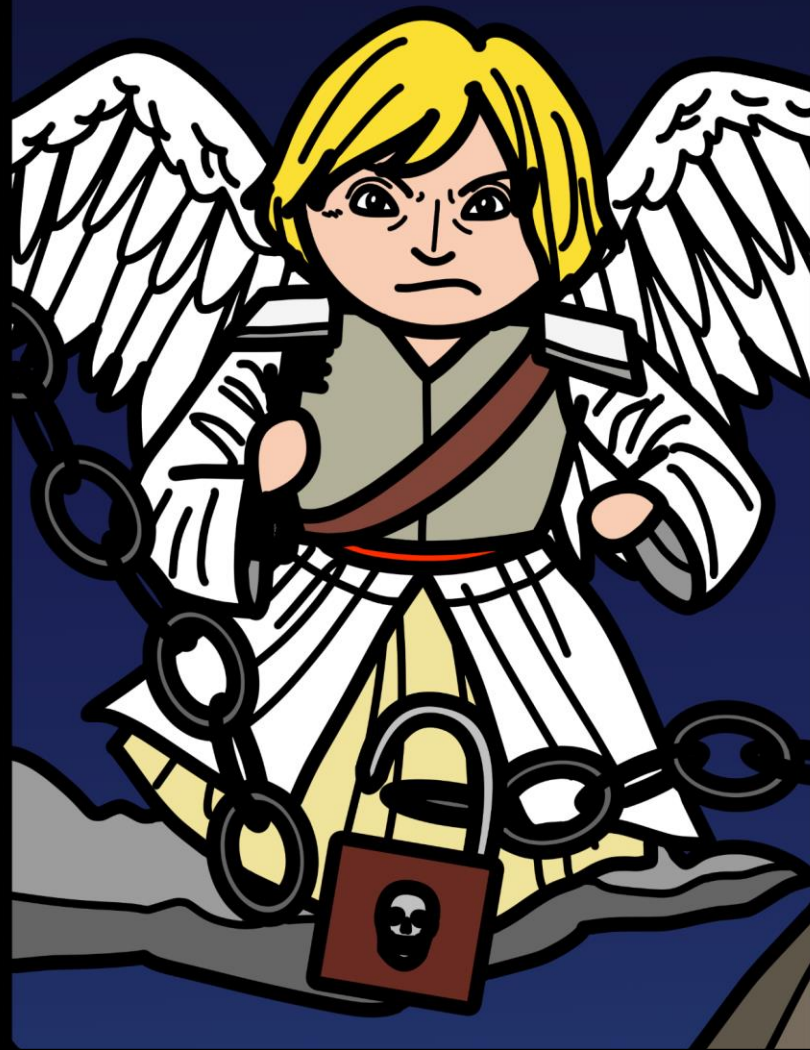
Background:

The key to the pit of the abyss was given to him. He opened the pit of the abyss,



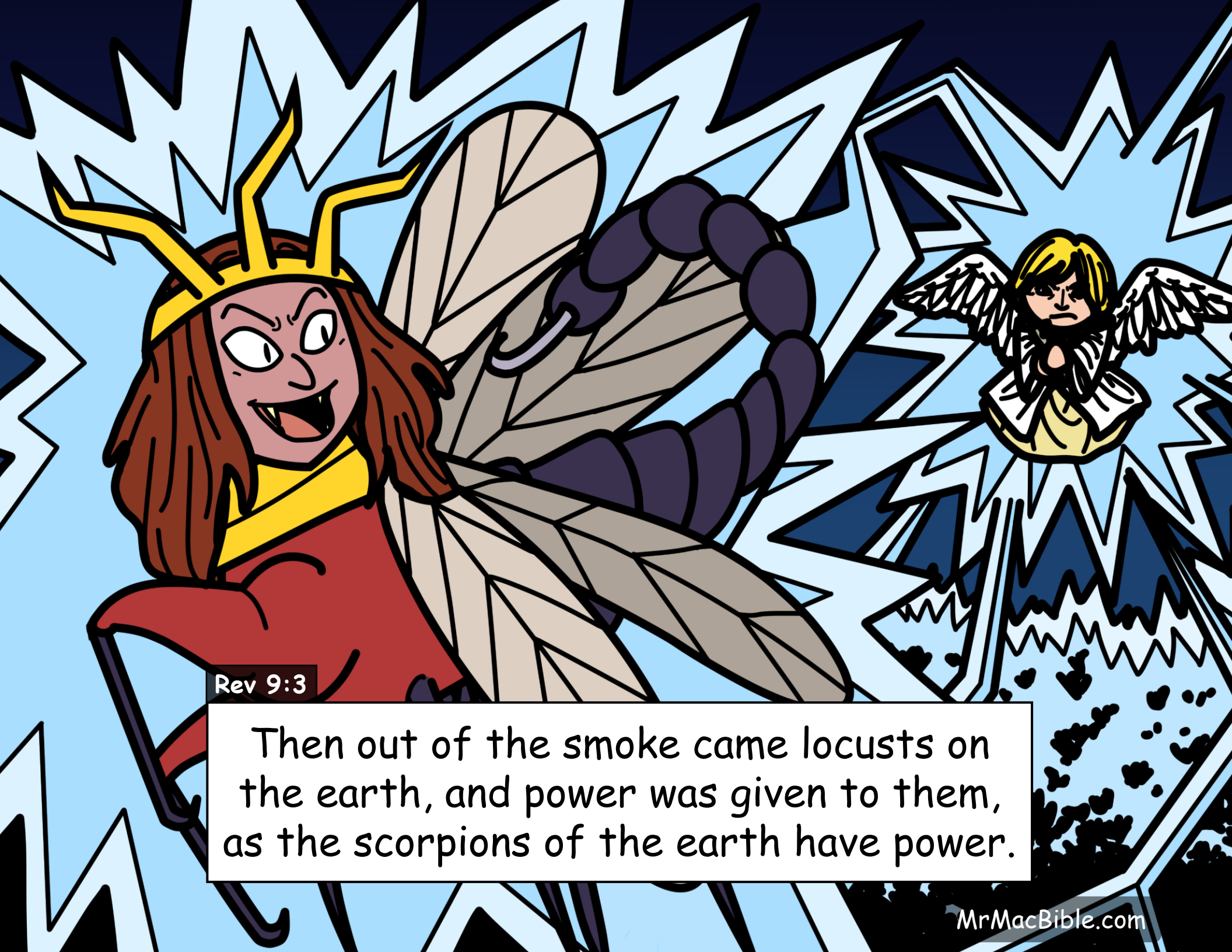
Rev 9:2

because of the smoke from the pit.



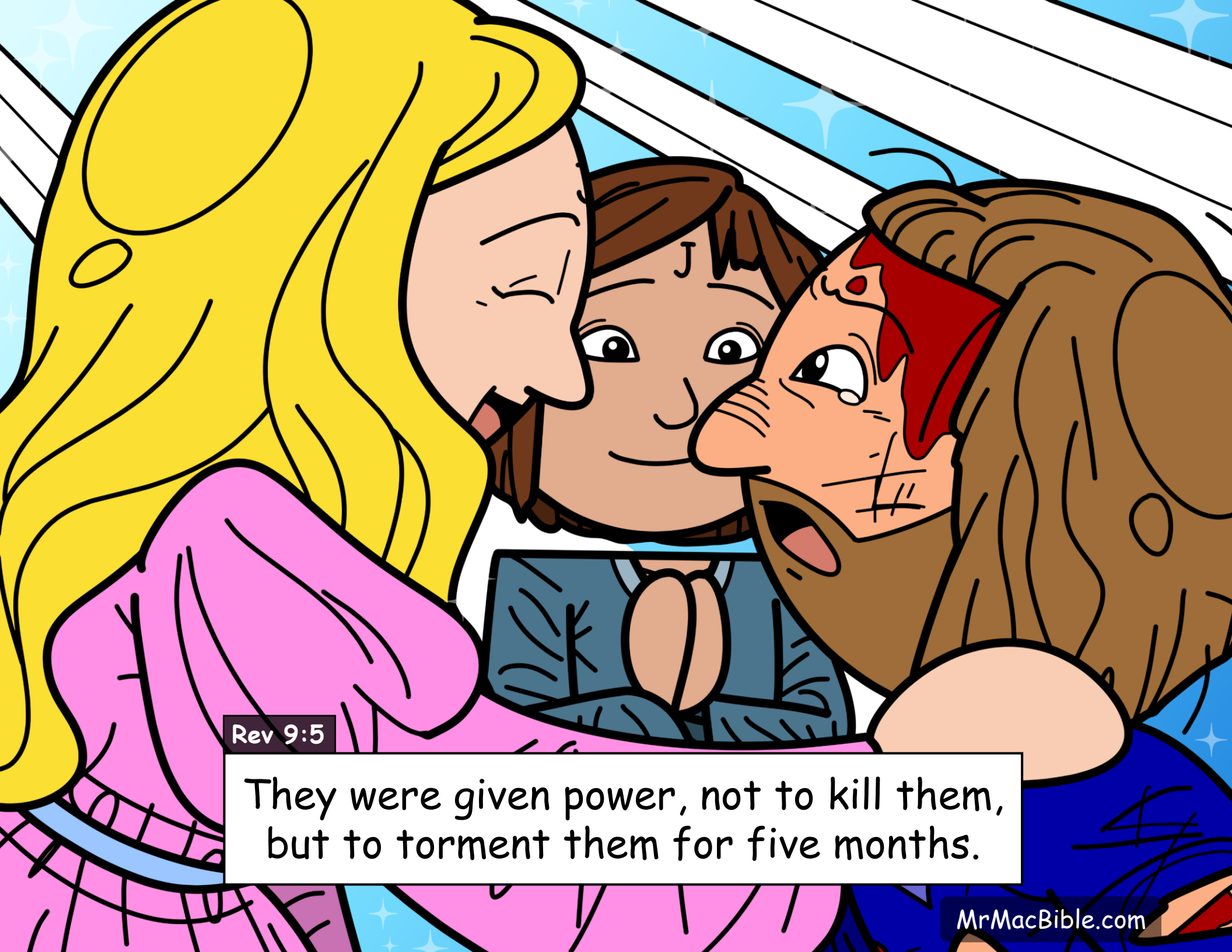
Rev 9:3

The shapes of the locusts were like horses prepared for war.



Rev 9:7

On their heads were something like golden crowns, and their faces were like people's faces.



Rev 9:8

They had hair like women's hair, and their teeth were like those of lions.



Rev 9:9

They had breastplates like breastplates of iron.
The sound of their wings was like the sound of
many chariots and horses rushing to war.



Harm but not kill

Rev 9:10

They have tails like those of scorpions, with stingers. In their tails they have power to harm men for five months.



Rev 9:11

They have over them as king the angel of the abyss. His name in Hebrew is "Abaddon", but in Greek, he has the name "Apollyon".

The scorpion monsters are not allowed to kill men and women, but only terrify and torment them for five months.

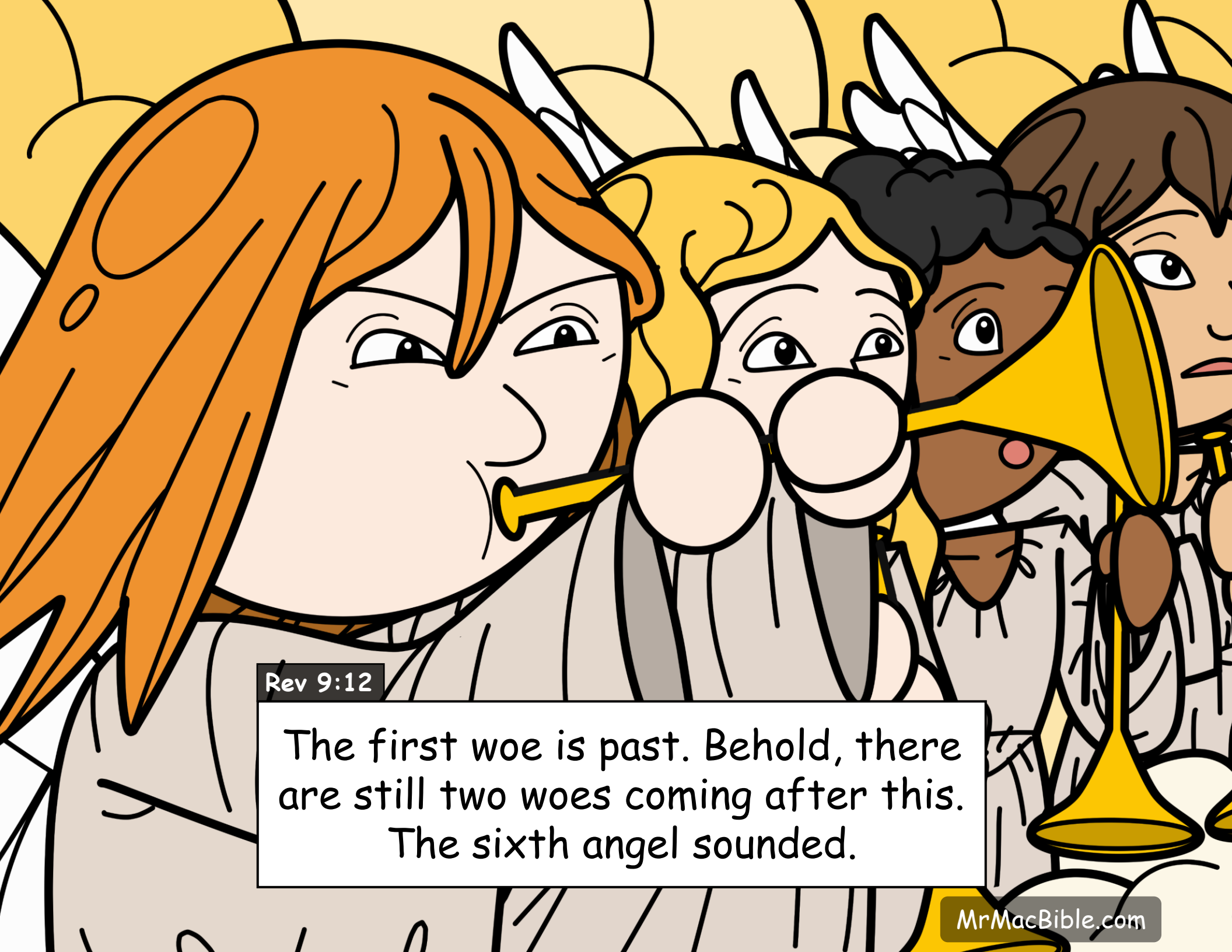

Attack of the Lion Snake Monsters! Rev 9:12-21

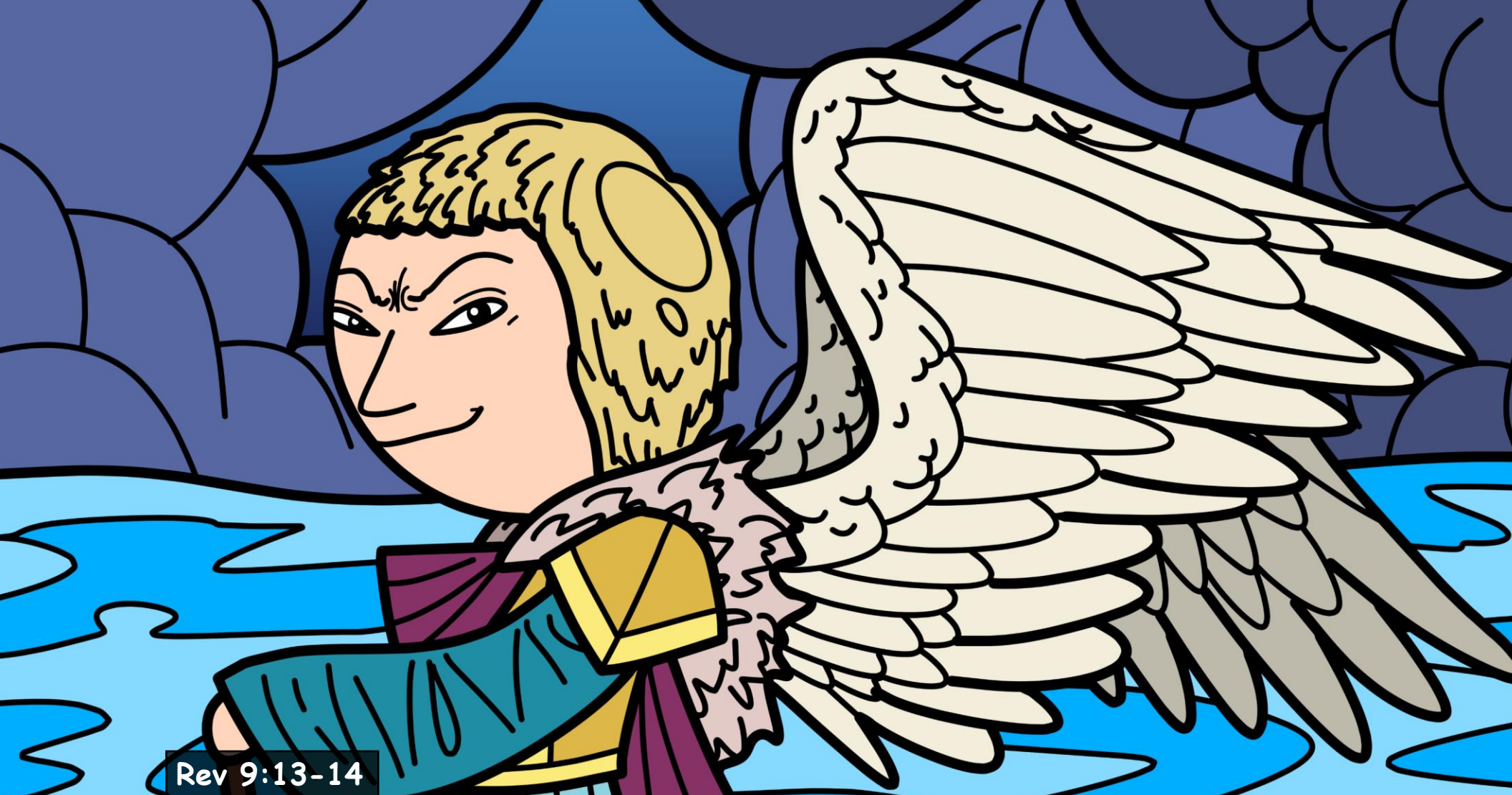
Background:

But the people continue to curse God!



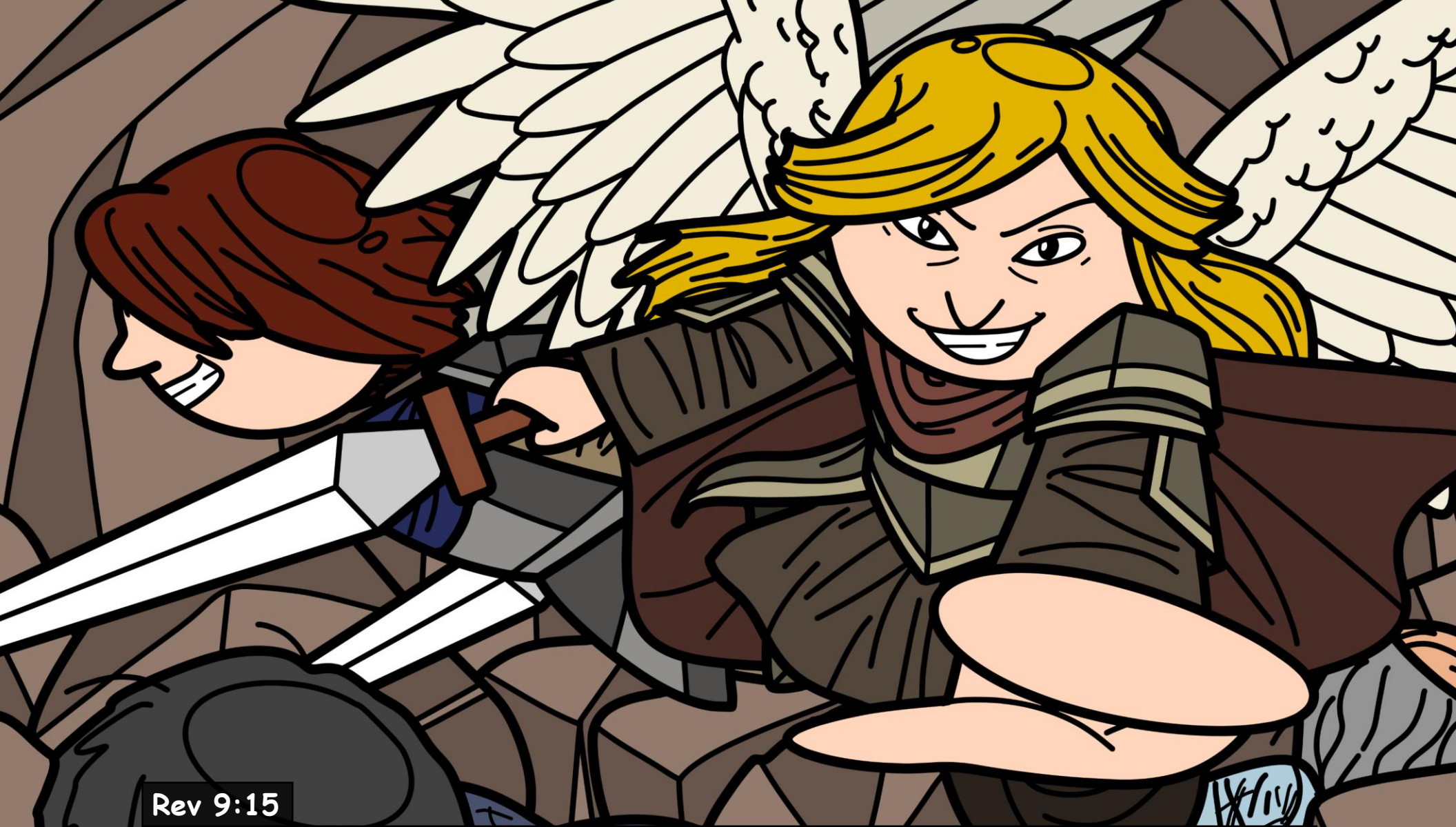
Rev 9:12

The four angels were freed who had been prepared for that hour and day and month and year, so that they might kill one third of mankind.



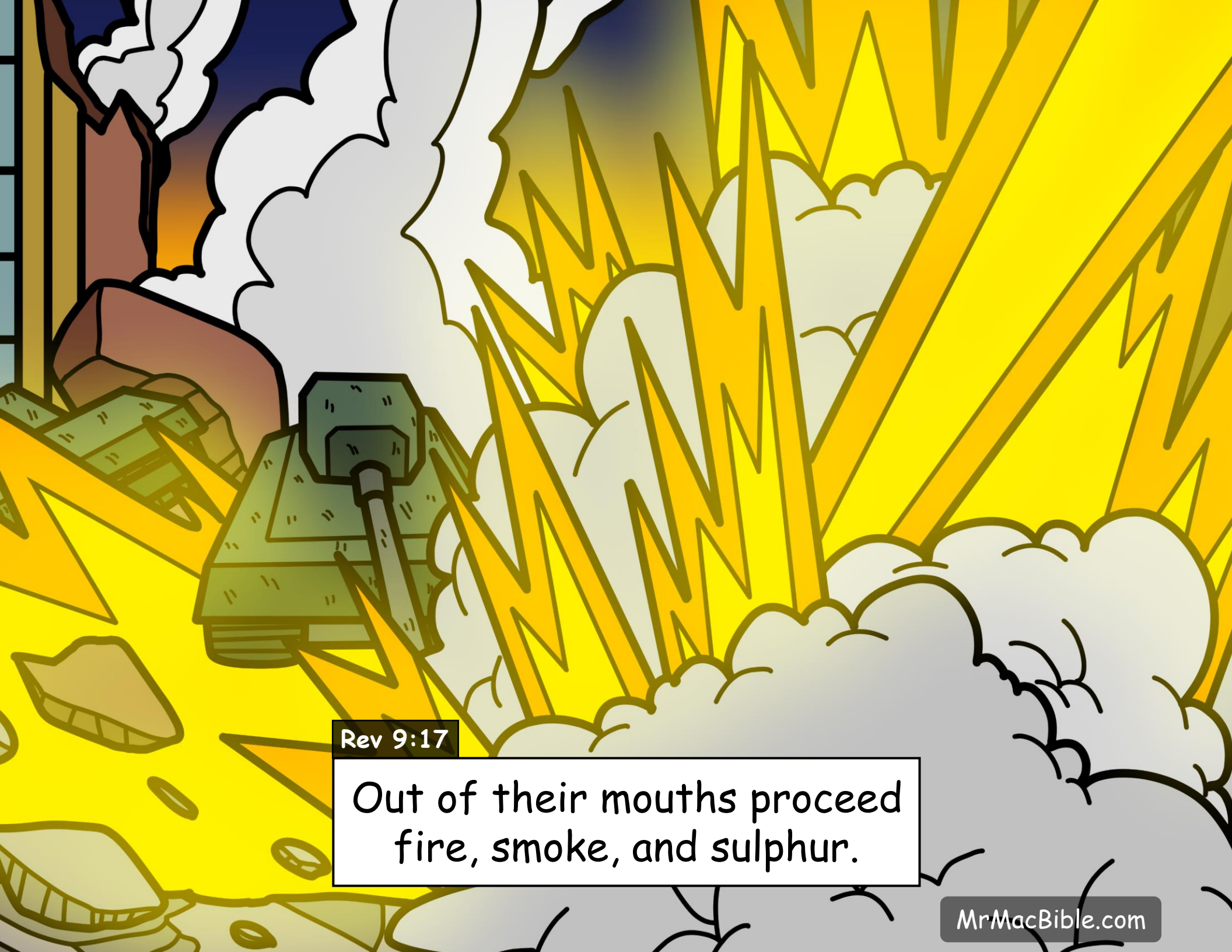
Rev 9:16

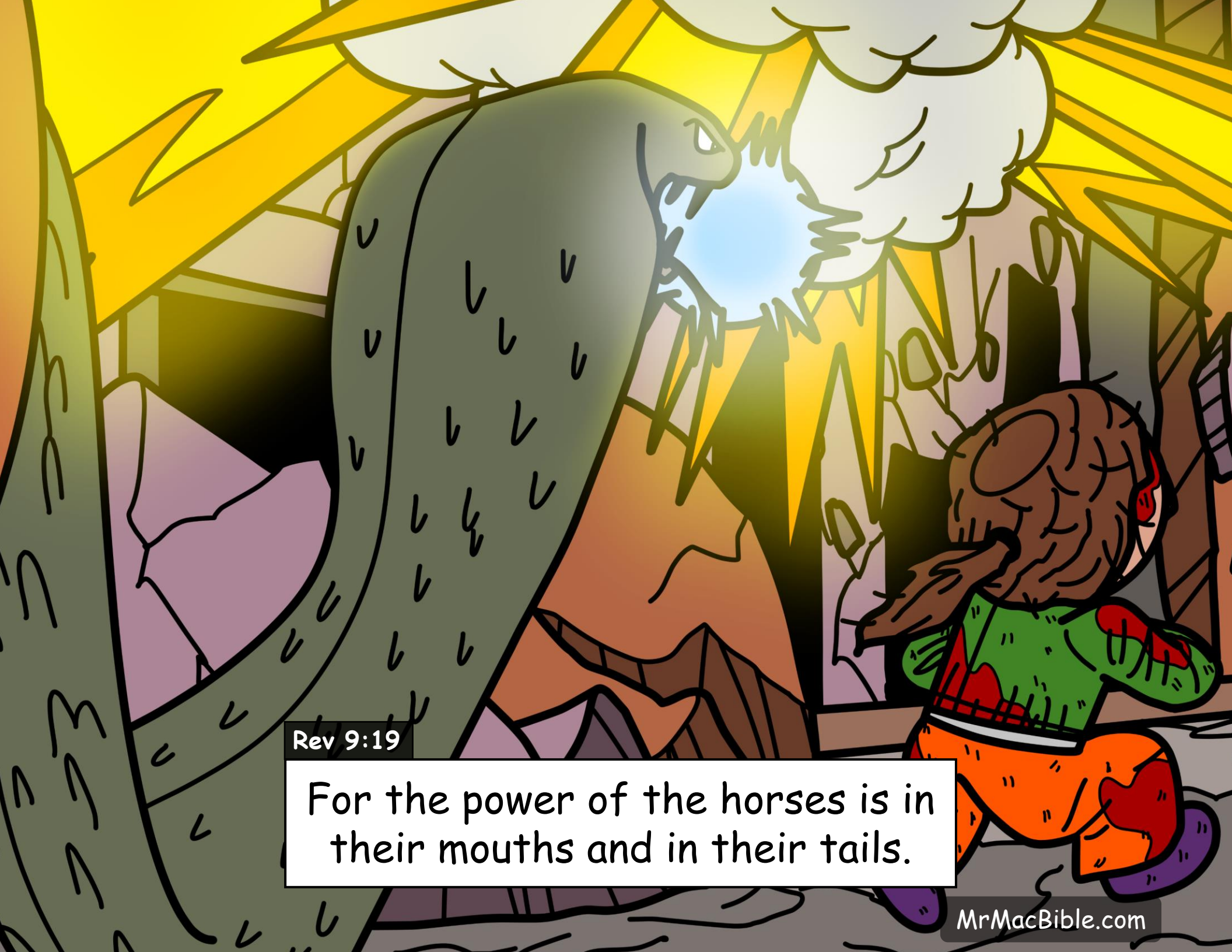
Rev 9:17

God is ready to declare that his mysterious grand plan for mankind is complete!



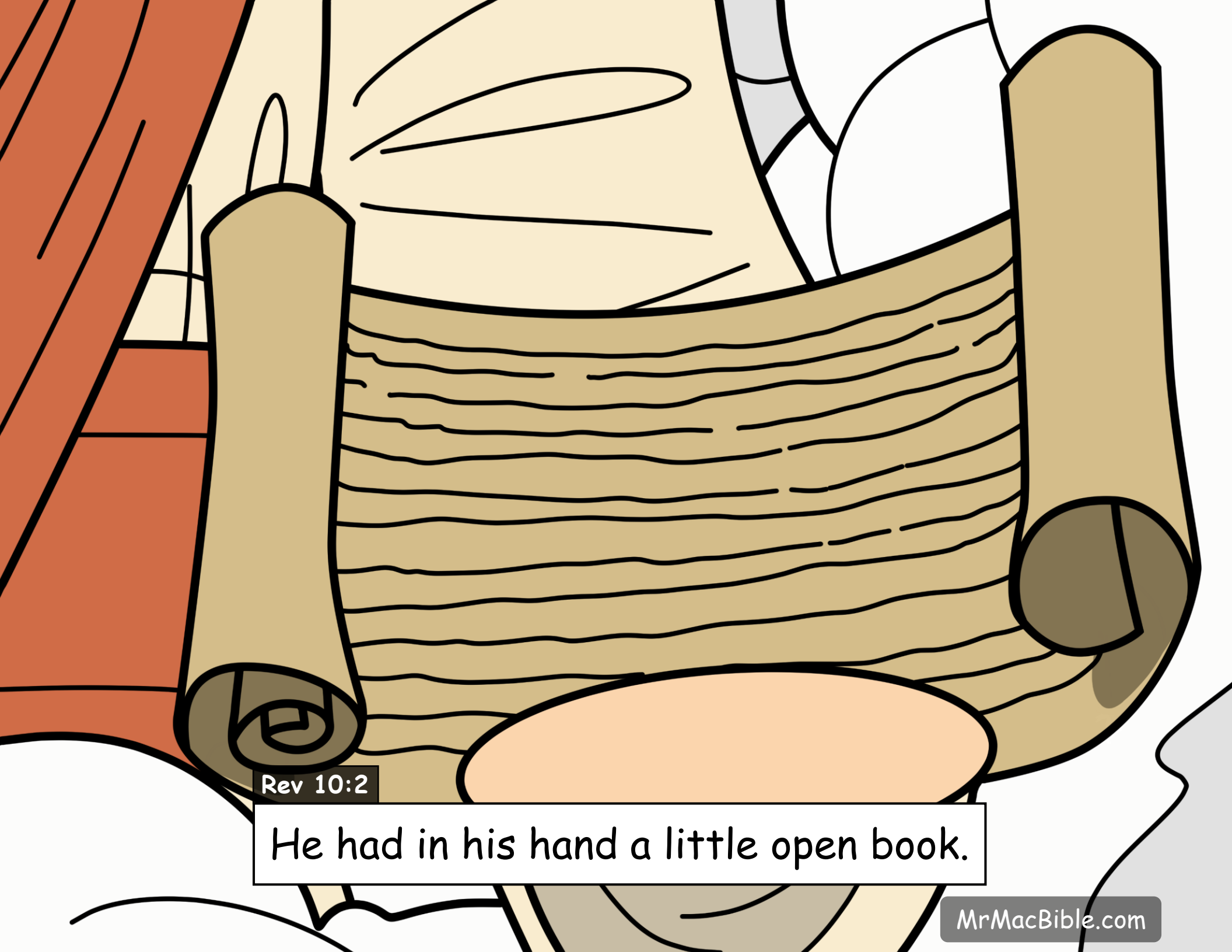
Rev 10:1

A rainbow was on his head. His face was like the sun, and his feet like pillars of fire.



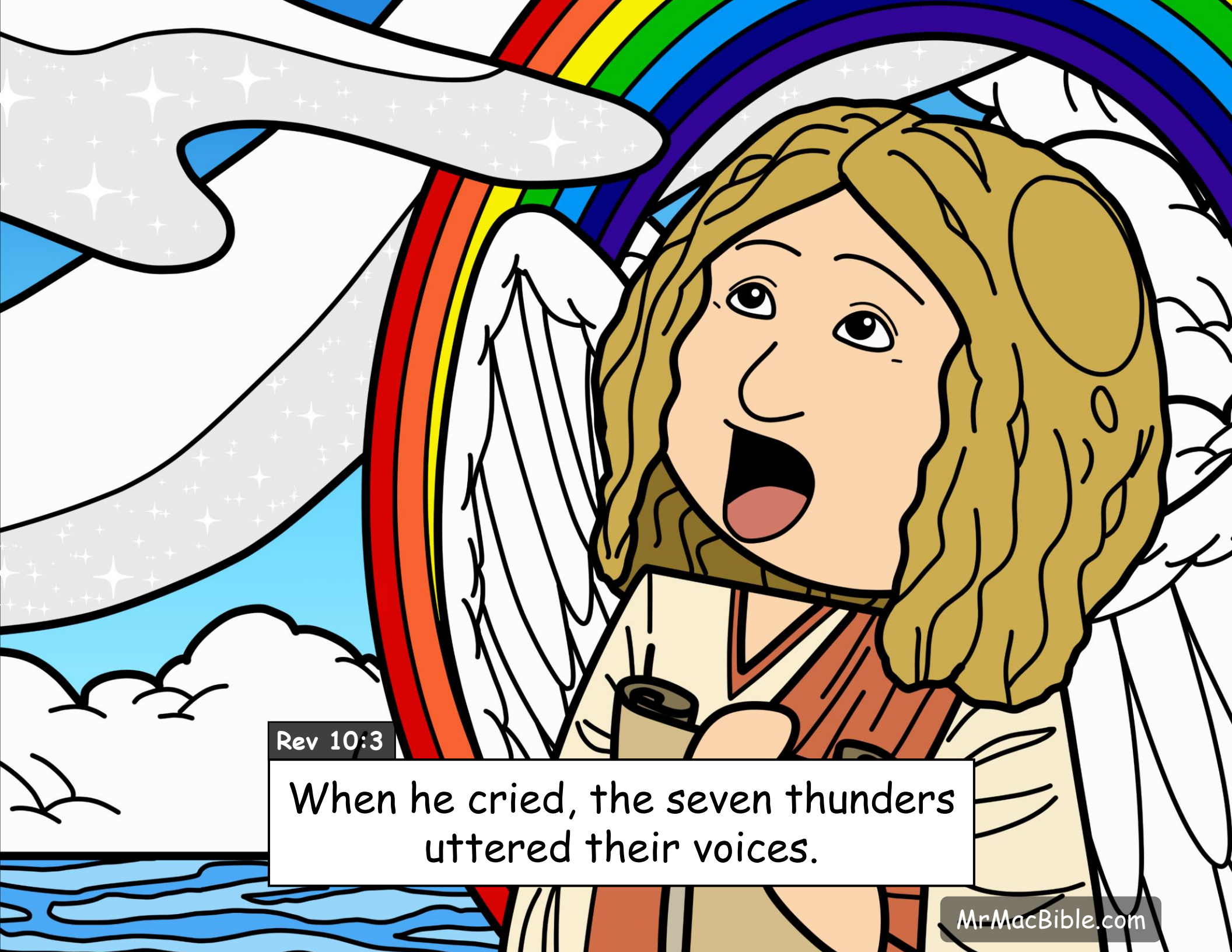
Rev 10:2

When he cried, the seven thunders uttered their voices.



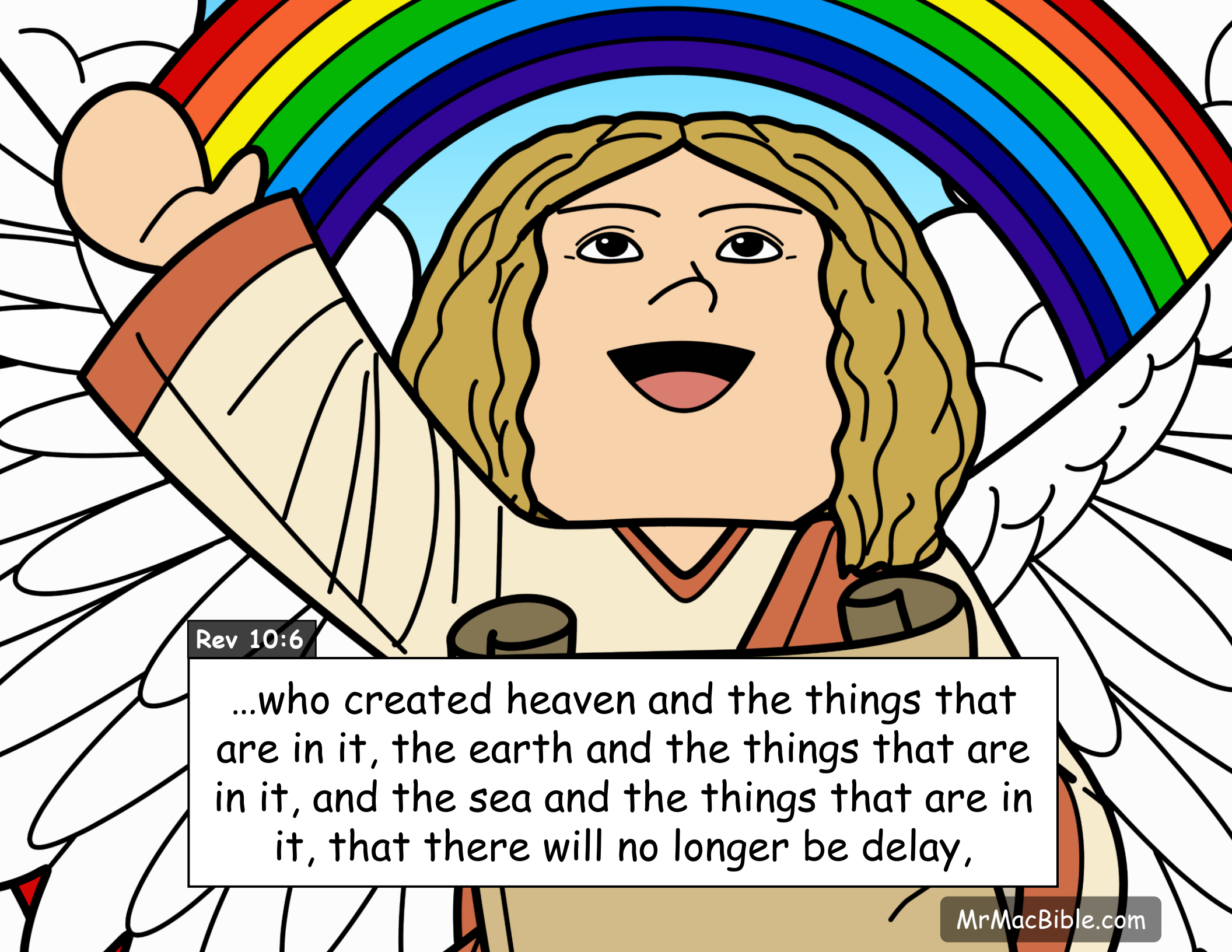
Rev 10:4

Rev 11:1-12

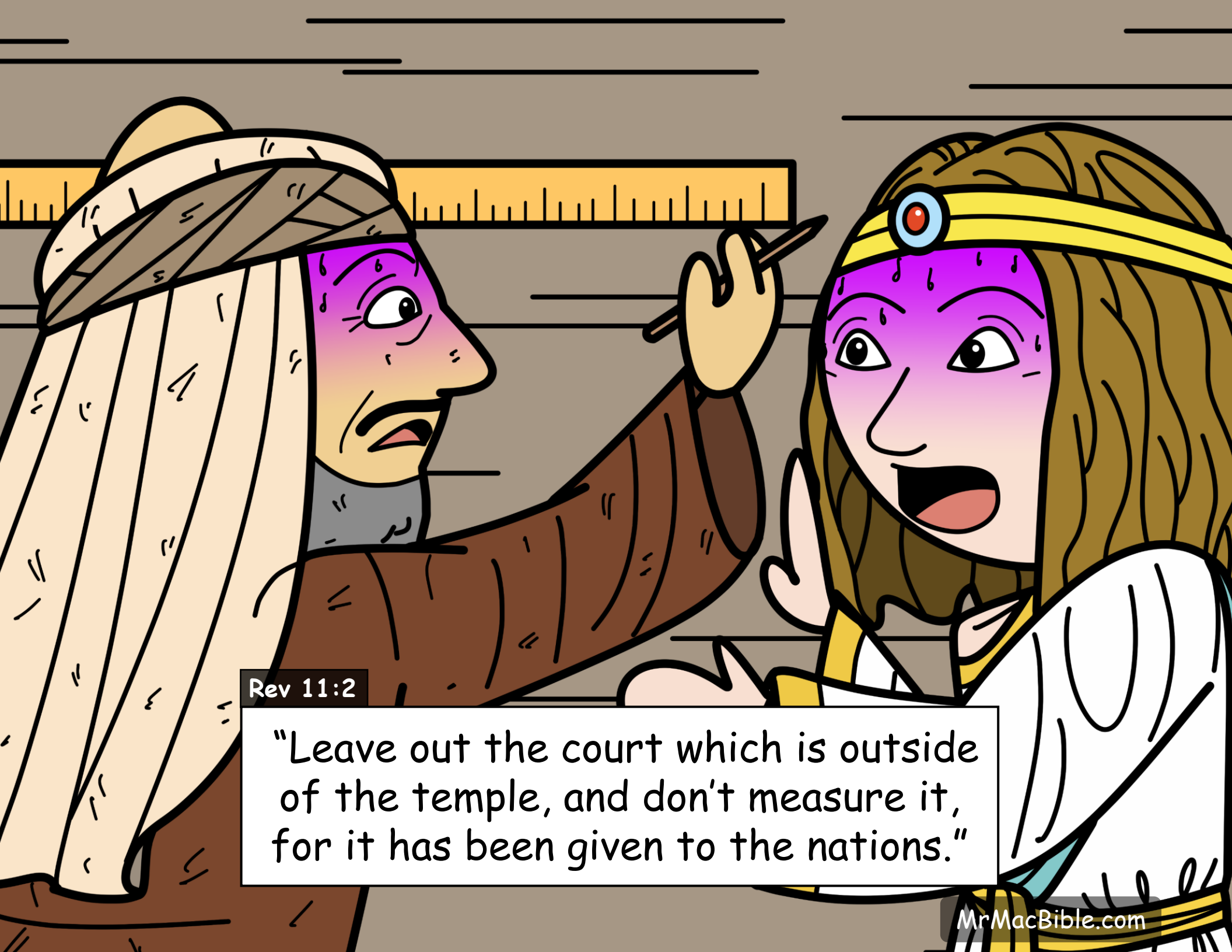
Background:

A reed like a rod was given to me. Someone said, "Rise and measure God's temple, and the altar, and those who worship in it."



Rev 11:2

"Leave out the court which is outside of the temple, and don't measure it, for it has been given to the nations."



Rev 11:2

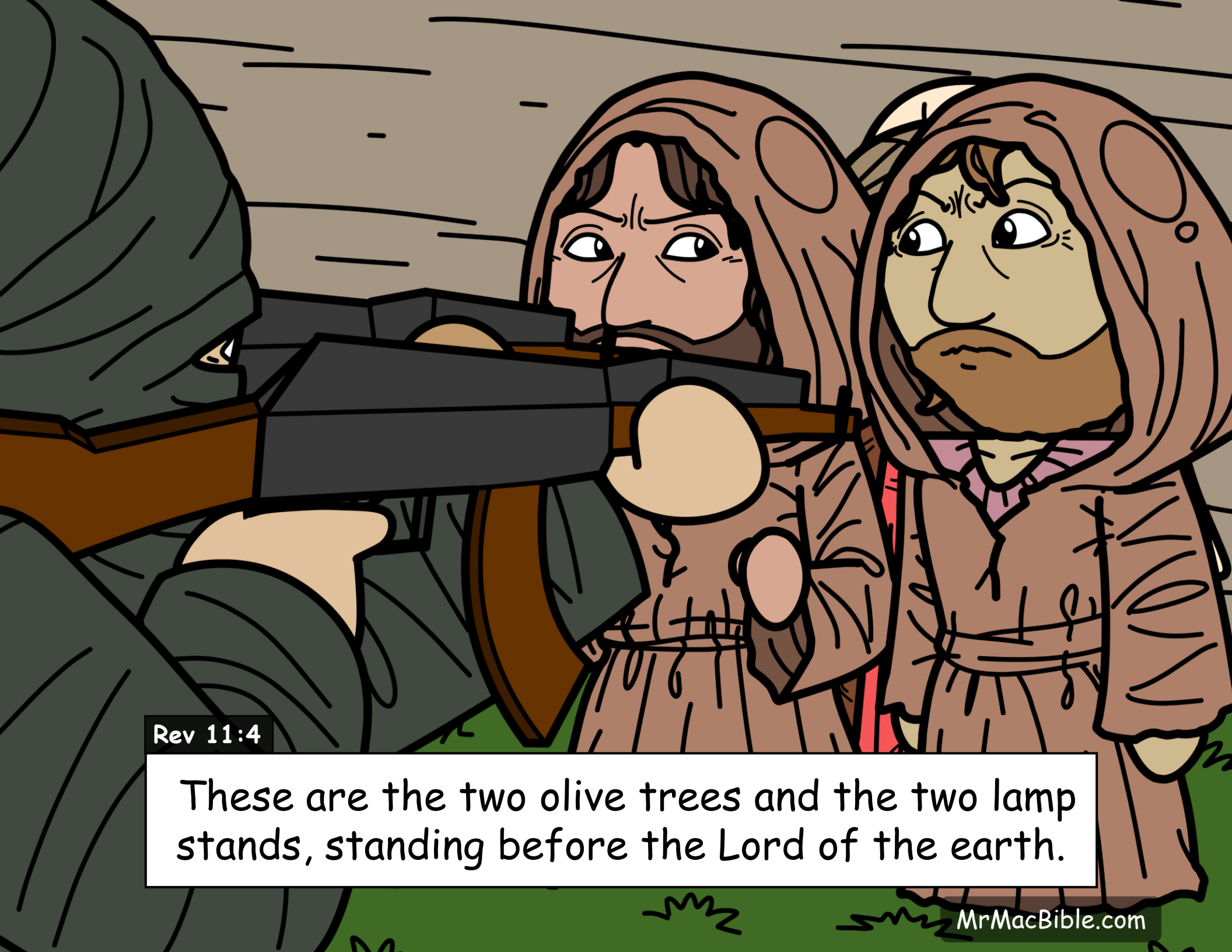
"They will tread the holy city under foot for forty-two months."



Moses and Elijah return?

Rev 11:8

"I will give power to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy one thousand and two hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth."



Rev 11:4

These are the two olive trees and the two lamp stands, standing before the Lord of the earth.



Rev 11:5

If anyone desires to harm them,
he must be killed in this way.



Rev 11:6

These have the power to shut up the sky, that it may not rain during the days of their prophecy.




Rev 11:6

They have power over the waters, to turn them into blood, and to strike the earth with every plague, as often as they desire.

When they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes up out of the abyss will make war with them, and overcome them, and kill them.

I heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, "Come up here!"

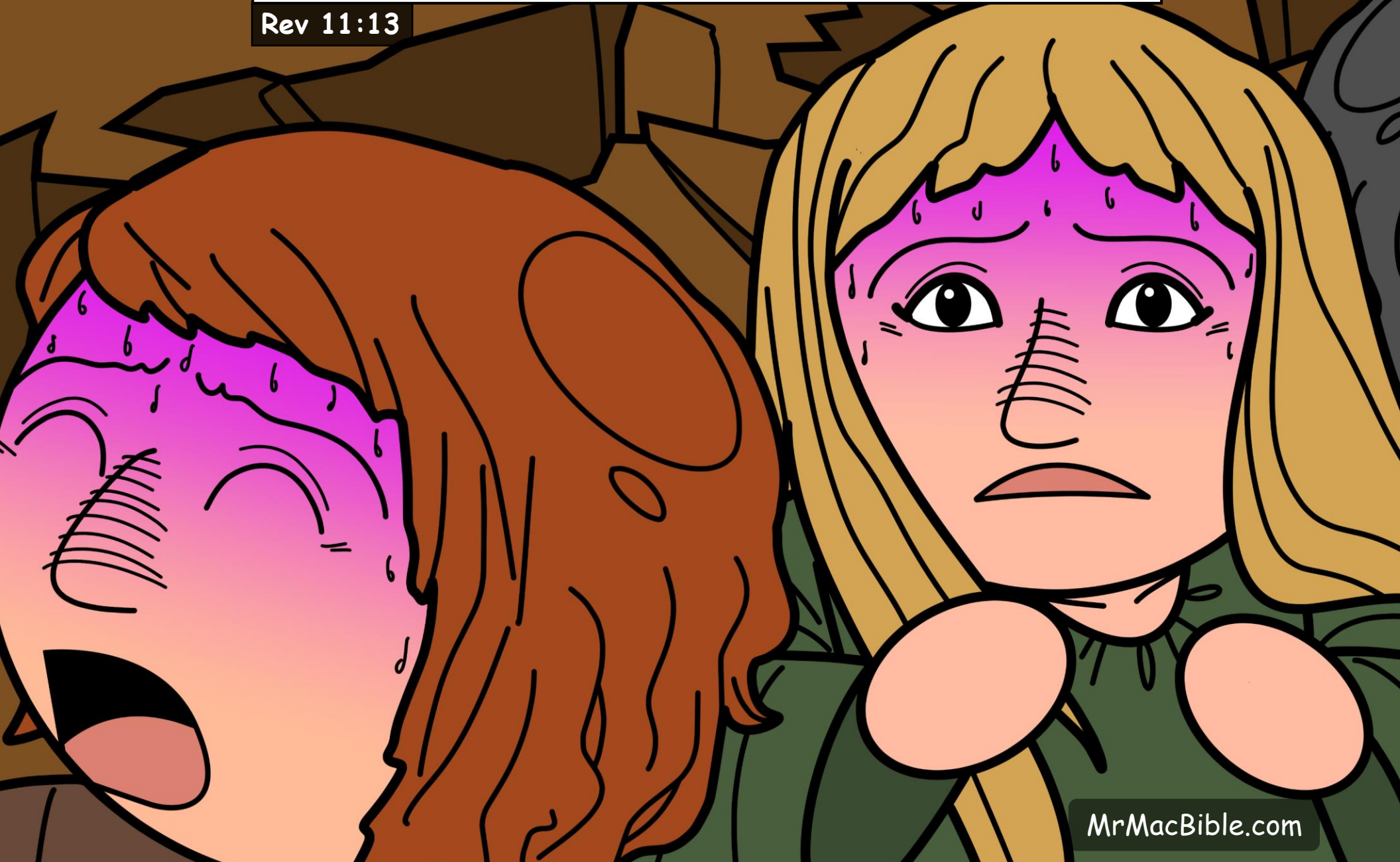


They went up into heaven in a cloud,

The seventh angel sounded, and great voices in heaven followed, saying,...



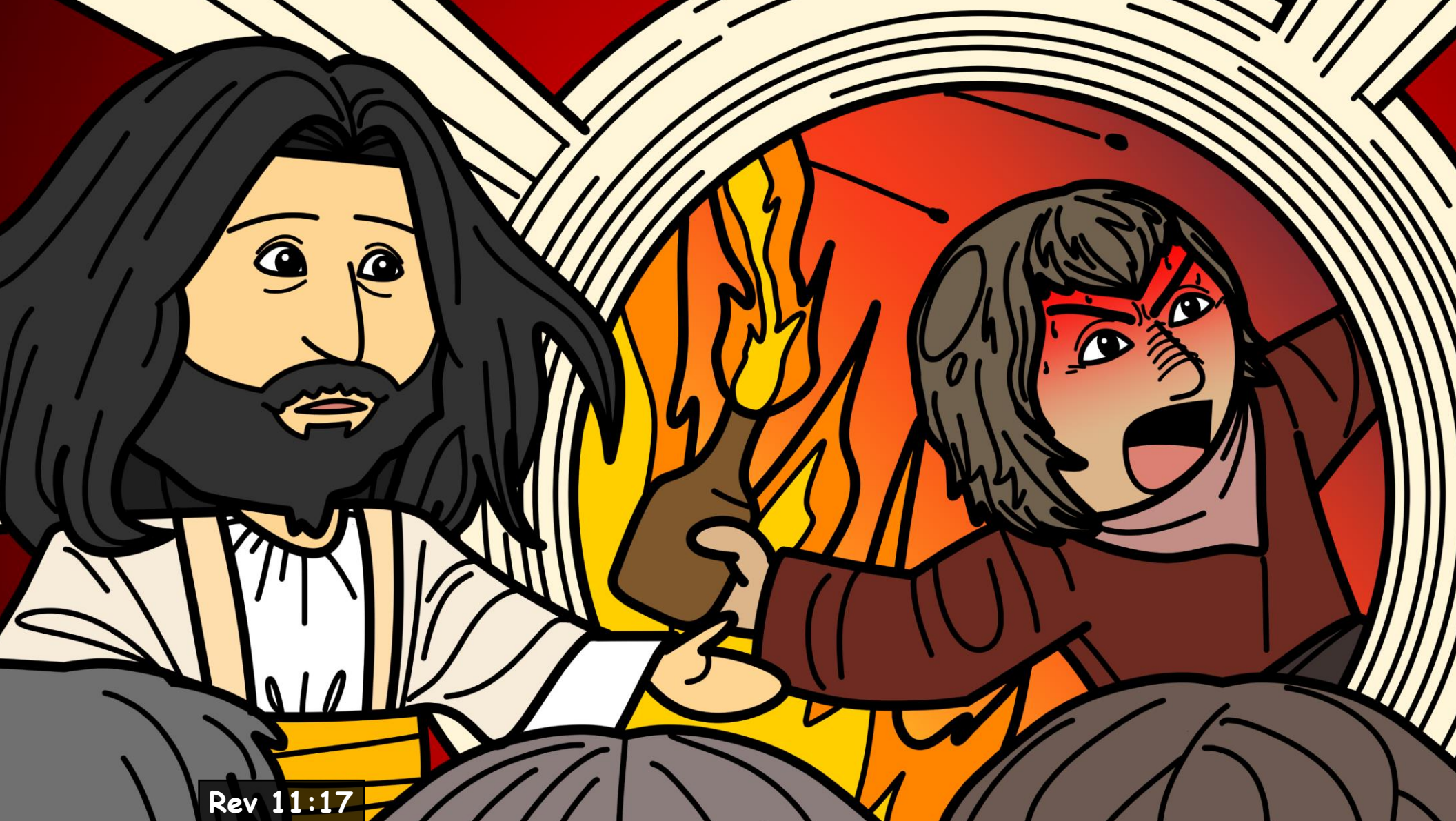
Rev 11:15

God's enemies continue to loot and destroy...

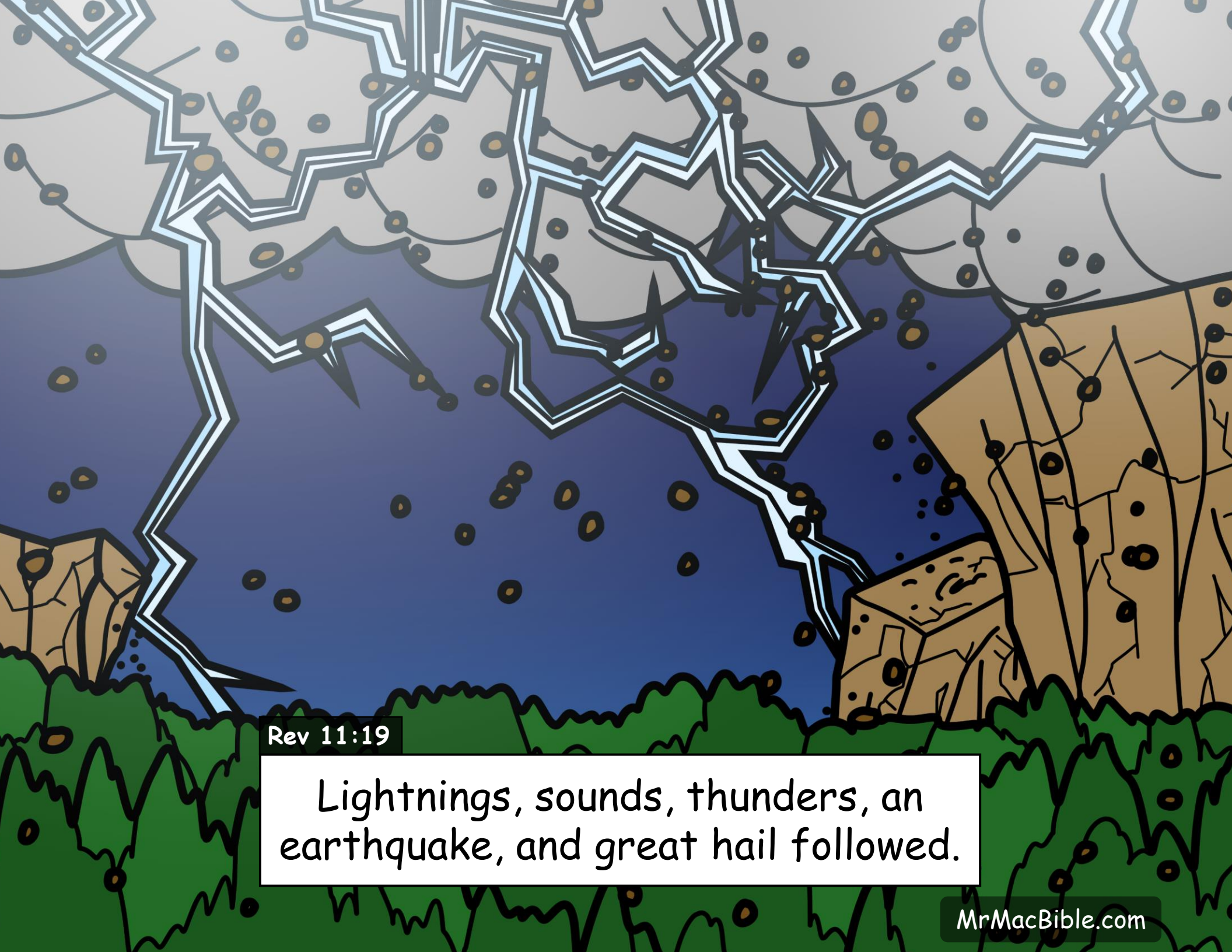
Rev 11:18

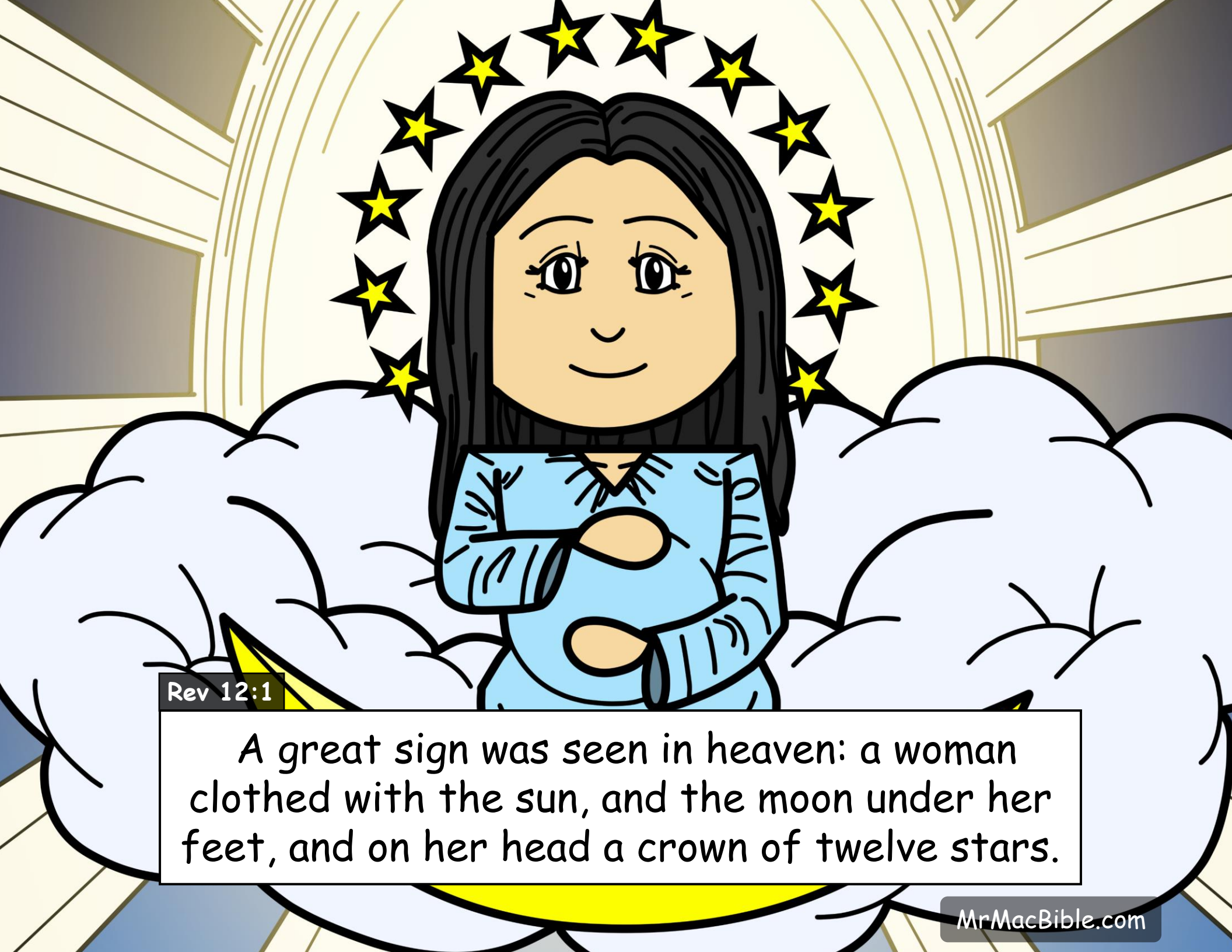
The Woman + Dragon

Rev 12:1

A great sign was seen in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.



Rev 12:2

She was with child. She cried out in pain, labouring to give birth.



Rev 12:3

Another sign was seen in heaven. Behold, a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his heads seven crowns.



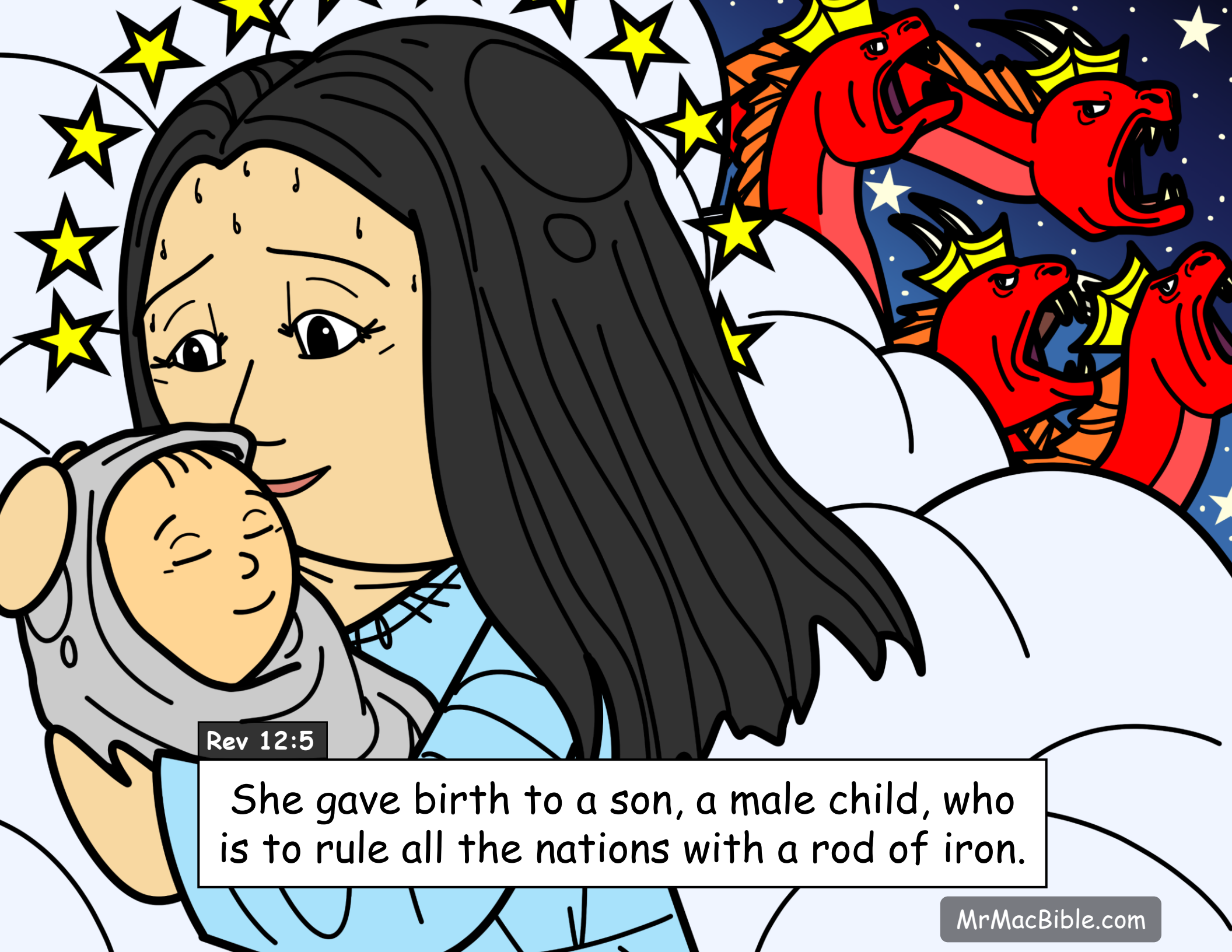
Rev 12:4

His tail drew one third of the stars of the sky, and threw them to the earth.



Rev 12:4

The dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, so that when she gave birth he might devour her child.



Rev 12:5

She gave birth to a son, a male child, who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron.



The symbolic child (Jesus)

Her child was caught up

There was war in the sky. Michael and his angels made war on the dragon.



Rev 12:7

The dragon and his angels made war.




Rev 12:8

They didn't prevail. No place was found for them any more in heaven.



Rev 12:9

The great dragon was thrown down, the old serpent, he who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world.



Satan is pushed through the portal to the earth...

Rev 12:9

He was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.



Satan no longer has access to the heavenlies...

Rev 12:10

I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now the salvation, the power, and the Kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Christ has come;"



Rev 12:10

...for the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them before our God day and night.



God's people defeat Satan by being fearless!

Rev 12:11

They overcame him because of the Lamb's blood, and because of the word of their testimony.



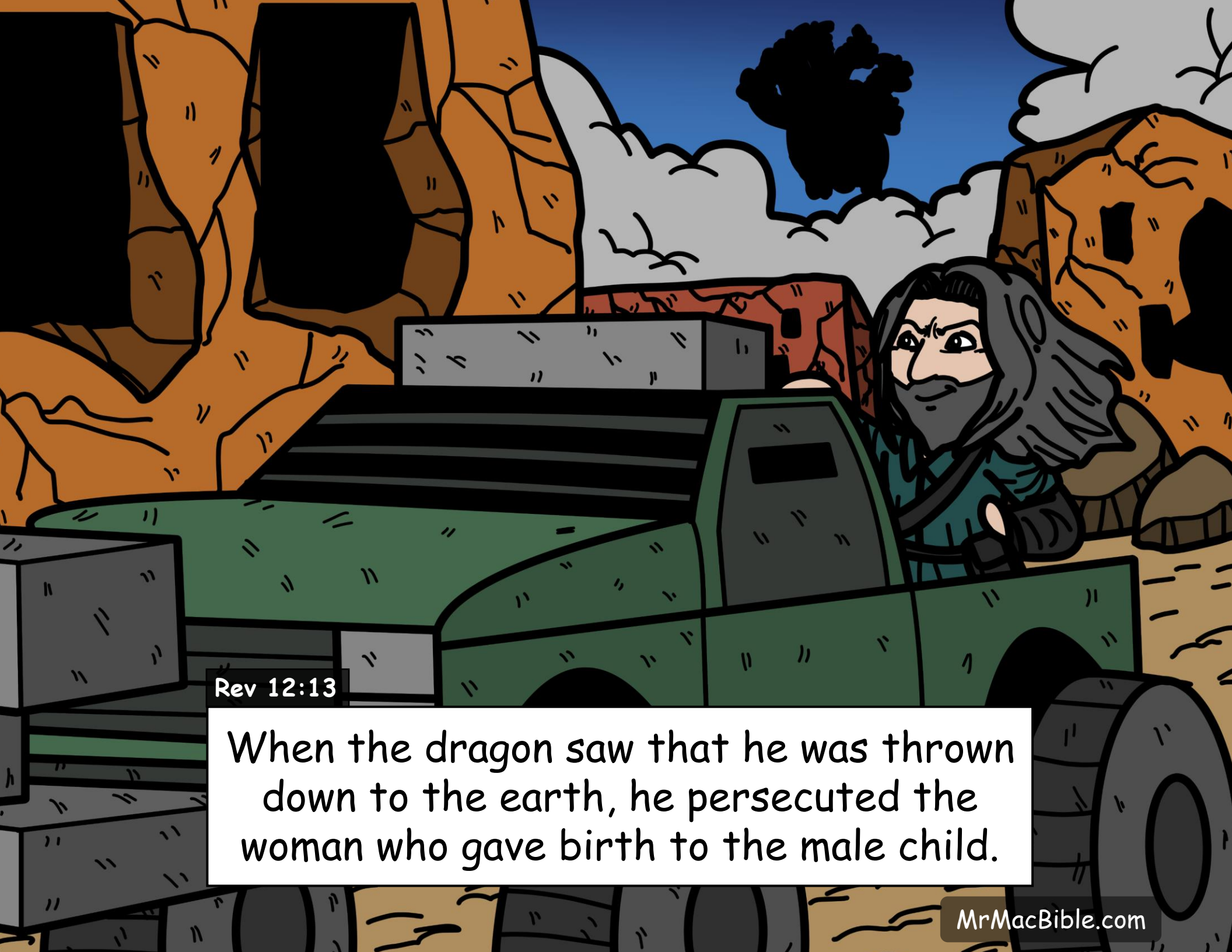
Rev 12:12

They didn't love their life, even to death. Therefore rejoice, heavens, and you who dwell in them.

Woe to the earth and to the sea, because the devil has gone down to you, having great wrath, knowing that he has but a short time.



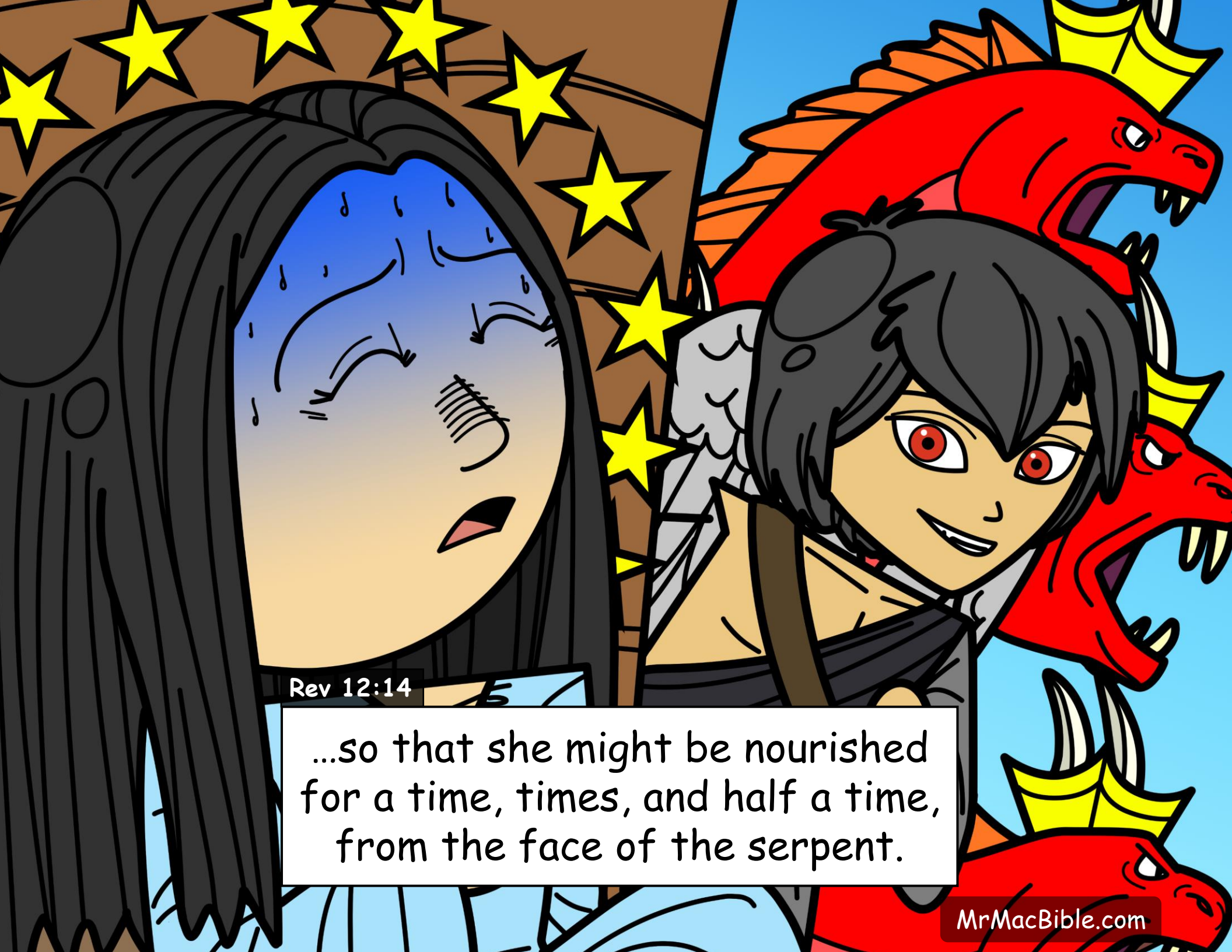
Rev 12:13

The serpent spewed water out of his mouth after the woman like a river, that he might cause her to be carried away by the stream.

The earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed up the river which the dragon spewed out of his mouth.



Rev 12:17

The dragon grew angry with the woman, and went away to make war with the rest of her offspring,



Rev 12:17

...to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep God's commandments and hold Jesus' testimony.

Rev 13:5

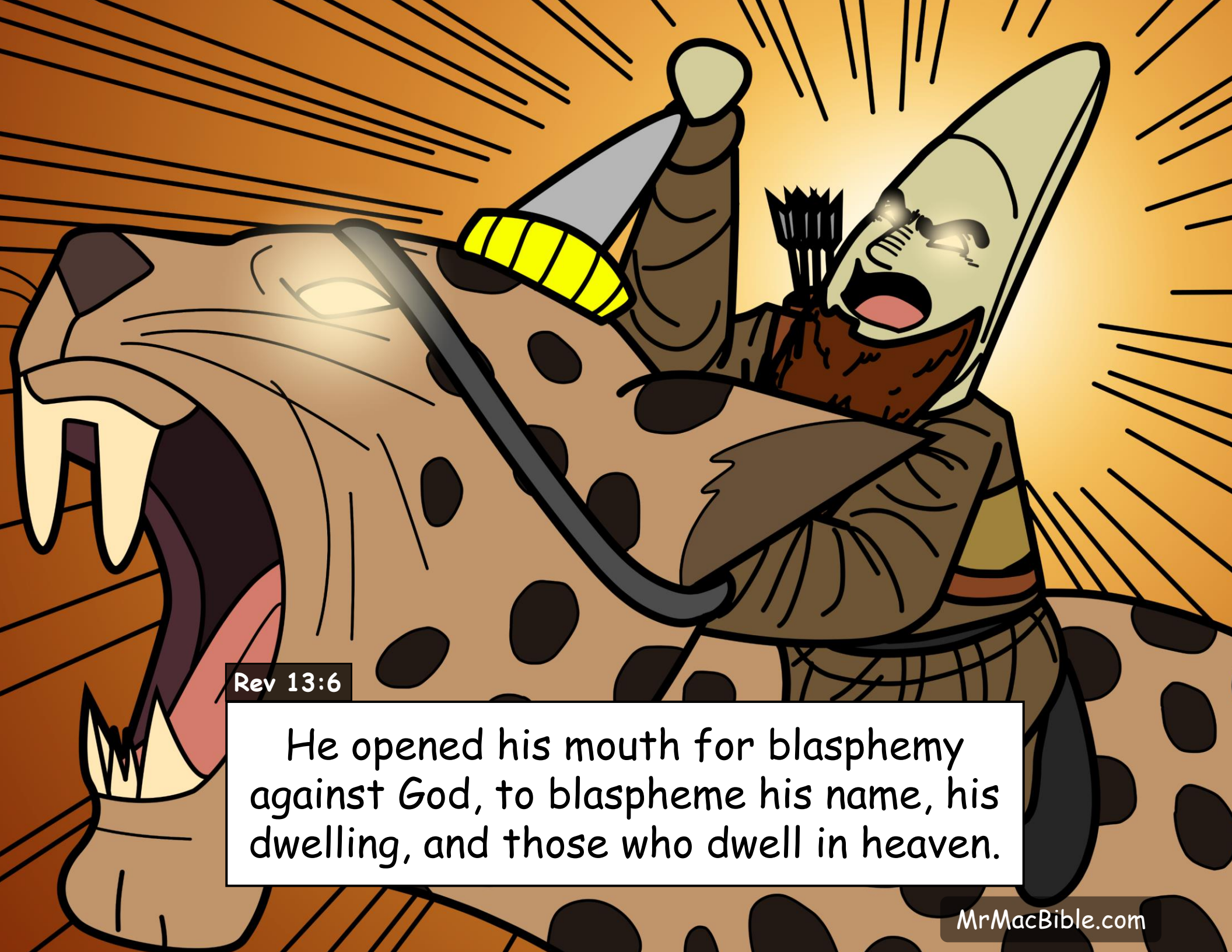
A mouth speaking great things

If anyone has an ear, let him hear. If anyone is to go into captivity, he will go into captivity.

If anyone is to be killed with the sword, he must be killed. Here is the endurance and the faith of the saints.

I saw another beast coming up out of the earth. He had two horns like a lamb and it spoke like a dragon.




Rev 13:12

He exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence.



Rev 13:12

He makes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose fatal wound was healed.

He performs great signs, even making fire come down out of the sky to the earth in the sight of people.



Rev 13:14


He deceives my own people who dwell on the earth because of the signs he was granted to do in front of the beast,

4 I heard the number of those who were sealed, 140,000 sealed out of every tribe of the children of Israel: of the tribes sealed:

Gad 12,000,	Levi 12,000,
Asher 12,000,	Issachar 12,000,
Naphtali 12,000,	Zebulun 12,000,

Joseph 12,000, and Benjamin 12,000.

9 After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no man could count, out of every nation and of all tribes, peoples, and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, dressed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands.

10 They cried with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation be to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"

11 All the angels were standing around the throne, the elders, and the four living creatures; and they fell on their faces before his throne, and worshipped God, 12 saying,

"Amen! Blessing, glory, wisdom, thanksgiving, honour, power, and might, be to our God forever and ever! Amen."

13 One of the elders answered, saying to me, "These who are arrayed in the white robes, who are they, and where did they come from?"

14 I told him, "My lord, you know." He said to me, "These are those who came out of the great suffering."

Rev 7:14-8:11 14 They washed their robes and made them white in the Lamb's blood.

15 Therefore they are before the throne of God, and they serve him day and night in his temple. He who sits on the throne will spread his tabernacle over them.

16 They will never be hungry or thirsty any more. The sun won't beat on them, nor any heat;

17 for the Lamb who is in the middle of the throne shepherds them and leads them to springs of life-giving waters. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes."

8:1 When he opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. 2 I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them.

3 Another angel came and stood over the altar, having a golden censer. Much incense was given to him, that he should add it to the prayers of all the saints on the golden altar which was before the throne.

4 The smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, went up before God out of the angel's hand. 5 The angel took the censer, and he filled it with the fire of the altar, then threw it on the earth. Thunders, sounds, lightnings, and an earthquake followed.

6 The seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

7 The first sounded, and there followed hail and fire, mixed with blood, and they were thrown to the earth. One third of the earth was burnt up, and one third of the trees were burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.

8 The second angel sounded, and something like a great burning mountain was thrown into the sea. One third of the sea became blood, 9 and one third of the living creatures which were in the sea died. One third of the ships were destroyed.

10 The third angel sounded, and a great star fell from the sky, burning like a torch, and it fell on one third of the rivers, and on the springs of water. 11 The name of the star is "Wormwood." One third of the waters became wormwood.

BIBLE: Rev 8:11-9:9 11 Many people died from the waters, because they were made bitter.

12 The fourth angel sounded, and one third of the sun was struck, and one third of the moon, and one third of the stars, so that one third of them would be darkened; and the day wouldn't shine for one third of it, and the night in the same way.

13 I saw, and I heard an eagle, flying in mid heaven, saying with a loud voice, "Woe! Woe! Woe to those who dwell on the earth, because of the other blasts of the trumpets of the three angels, who are yet to sound!"

9:1 The fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star from the sky which had fallen to the earth. The key to the pit of the abyss was given to him.

2 He opened the pit of the abyss, and smoke went up out of the pit, like the smoke from a burning furnace. The sun and the air were darkened because of the smoke from the pit.

3 Then out of the smoke came locusts

...on the earth, and power was given to them, as the scorpions of the earth have power.

4 They were told that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree, but only those people who don't have God's seal on their foreheads.

5 They were given power, not to kill them, but to torment them for five months. Their torment was like the torment of a scorpion when it strikes a person.

6 In those days people will seek death, and will in no way find it. They will desire to die, and death will flee from them.

7 The shapes of the locusts were like horses prepared for war. On their heads were something like golden crowns, and their faces were like people's faces.

8 They had hair like women's hair, and their teeth were like those of lions.

9 They had breastplates like breastplates of iron.

Rev 9:9-10:1 The sound of their wings was like the sound of many chariots and horses rushing to war.

10 They have tails like those of scorpions, with stingers. In their tails they have power to harm men for five months.

11 They have over them as king the angel of the abyss. His name in Hebrew is "Abaddon", but in Greek, he has the name "Apollyon".

12 The first woe is past. Behold, there are still two woes coming after this. 13 The sixth angel sounded. I heard a voice from the horns of the golden altar which is before God, 14 saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Free the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates!"

15 The four angels were freed who had been prepared for that hour and day and month and year, so that they might kill one third of mankind.

16 The number of the armies of the horsemen was two hundred million. I heard the number of them.

17 Thus I saw the horses in the vision and those who sat on them, having breastplates of fiery red, hyacinth blue, and sulphur yellow; and the horses' heads resembled lions' heads. Out of their mouths proceed fire, smoke, and sulphur.

18 By these three plagues, one third of mankind was killed: by the fire, the smoke, and the sulphur, which proceeded out of their mouths.

19 For the power of the horses is in their mouths and in their tails. For their tails are like serpents, and have heads; and with them they harm.

20 The rest of mankind, who were not killed with these plagues, didn't repent of the works of their hands, that they wouldn't worship demons, and the idols of gold, and of silver, and of brass, and of stone, and of wood, which can't see, hear, or walk.

21 They didn't repent of their murders, their sorceries, their sexual immorality, or their thefts.

10:1 I saw a mighty angel coming down out of the sky, clothed with a cloud.

BIBLE: Rev 10:1-11:2 "A rainbow was on his head. His face was like the sun, and his feet like pillars of fire.

2 He had in his hand a little open book. He set his right foot on the sea, and his left on the land.

3 He cried with a loud voice, as a lion roars. When he cried, the seven thunders uttered their voices.

4 When the seven thunders sounded, I was about to write; but I heard a voice from the sky saying, "Seal up the things which the seven thunders said, and don't write them."

5 The angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land lifted up his right hand to the sky 6 and swore by him who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and the things that are in it, the earth and the things that are in it, and the sea and the things that are in it, that there will no longer be delay,

7 but in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, then the mystery of God is finished, as he declared to his servants the prophets.

8 The voice which I heard from heaven, again speaking with me, said, "Go, take the book which is open in the hand of the angel who stands on the sea and on the land."

9 I went to the angel, telling him to give me the little book.

He said to me, "Take it and eat it. It will make your stomach bitter, but in your mouth it will be as sweet as honey."

10 I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it. It was as sweet as honey in my mouth. When I had eaten it, my stomach was made bitter.

11 They told me, "You must prophesy again over many peoples, nations, languages, and kings."

11:1 A reed like a rod was given to me. Someone said, "Rise and measure God's temple, and the altar, and those who worship in it.

2 Leave out the court which is outside of the temple, and don't measure it, for it has been given to the nations.

Rev 11:2-13 2 They will tread the holy city under foot for forty-two months.

3 I will give power to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy one thousand and two hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth."

4 These are the two olive trees and the two lamp stands, standing before the Lord of the earth.

5 If anyone desires to harm them, fire proceeds out of their mouth and devours their enemies. If anyone desires to harm them, he must be killed in this way.

6 These have the power to shut up the sky, that it may not rain during the days of their prophecy. They have power over the waters, to turn them into blood, and to strike the earth with every plague, as often as they desire.

7 When they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes up out of the abyss will make war with them, and overcome them, and kill them.

8 Their dead bodies will be in the street of the great city, which spiritually

...is called Sodom and Egypt, where also their Lord was crucified.

9 From amongst the peoples, tribes, languages, and nations, people will look at their dead bodies for three and a half days, and will not allow their dead bodies to be laid in a tomb.

10 Those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them, and they will be glad. They will give gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth.

11 After the three and a half days, the breath of life from God entered into them, and they stood on their feet. Great fear fell on those who saw them.

12 I heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, "Come up here!" They went up into heaven in a cloud, and their enemies saw them.

13 In that day there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell. Seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake, and the rest were terrified and gave glory to the God of heaven.

BIBLE: Rev 11:14-12:6

14 The second woe is past. Behold, the third woe comes quickly.

15 The seventh angel sounded, and great voices in heaven followed, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the Kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ. He will reign forever and ever!"

16 The twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God's throne, fell on their faces and worshipped God, 17 saying:

"We give you thanks, Lord God, the Almighty, the one who is and who was, because you have taken your great power and reigned.

14 Two wings of the great eagle were given to the woman, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, so that she might be nourished for a time, times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

15 The serpent spewed water out of his mouth after the woman like a river, that he might cause her to be carried away by the stream.

16 The earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed up the river which the dragon spewed out of his mouth.

17 The dragon grew angry with the woman, and went away to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep God's commandments and hold Jesus' testimony.

13:1 Then I stood on the sand of the sea. I saw a beast coming up out of the sea, having ten horns and seven heads. On his horns were ten crowns,

BIBLE: Rev 13:1-14

...and on his heads, blasphemous names.

2 The beast which I saw was like a leopard, and his feet were like those of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority.

9 If anyone has an ear, let him hear.
10 If anyone is to go into captivity, he will go into captivity. If anyone is to be killed with the sword, he must be killed. Here is the endurance and the faith of the saints.

11 I saw another beast coming up out of the earth. He had two horns like a lamb and it spoke like a dragon.

12 He exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence. He makes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose fatal wound was healed.

13 He performs great signs, even making fire come down out of the sky to the earth in the sight of people.

14 He deceives my own people who dwell on the earth because of the signs

Rev 13:14-14:7 14 ... he was granted to do in front of the beast, saying to those who dwell on the earth that they should make an image to the beast who had the sword wound and lived.

15 It was given to him to give breath to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause as many as wouldn't worship the image of the beast to be killed.

16 He causes all, the small and the great, the rich and the poor, and the free and the slave, to be given marks on their right hands or on their foreheads; 17 and that no one would be able to buy or to sell unless he has that mark, which is the name of the beast or the number of his name.
